SUBJECT: Cancellation of Acquisition Bulletins (ABs) 02-20, 02-24, 03-05, and 05-06, related to Acquisition E-Government systems.

Purpose: Cancellation of the following ABs: 02-20, 02-24, 03-05, and 05-06. This AB cancels the AB 02-20 requirement for calculating cost savings and reporting them to the Treasury Acquisition Data System (TADS), the AB 02-24 notice of significant changes to the TADS and FPDS systems, and the AB 03-05 and related AB 05-06 requirement for populating the Inter-Agency Contract Directory (ICD).

Effective Date: This AB is effective immediately.

Expiration Date: Not applicable.

Background: AB 02-20 and AB 02-24 provided guidance to Treasury procurement personnel regarding the use and implementation of TADS. TADS is a legacy system and has been replaced by the Federal Procurement Data System (FPDS). As such, these ABs are no longer relevant. AB 03-05 and AB 05-06 focus on the Inter-Agency Contract Directory (ICD), which has been replaced by a Search capability within the FPDS system. As a result, the ICD is no longer operational, making these ABs obsolete.

Action: AB 02-20, 02-24, 03-05, and 05-06 are cancelled. No Bureau action is required.
