Authority to Administer Oath of Office

Authority: Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended (5 U.S.C. App. 3), the Internal Revenue Service Restructuring and Reform Act of 1998 (Public L. 105-206), and Treasury Order 115-01.

1. In Headquarters, the Assistant Director of Personnel, Personnel Specialists, and the Personnel Office staff members responsible for processing appointment actions, are hereby delegated the authority to administer the oaths of office to all new Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration employees, regardless of type of appointment or work schedule, when, or before, they report for duty as required by Title 5 U.S. Code, Section 3331, Title 5 U.S.C. Section 3332, and Title 5 U.S.C. 3333.
2. In field locations, the Special Agent-in-Charge and the Director are delegated the authority in 1 above. This authority may be redelegated in writing to the senior official in a remote post-of-duty.
