Dear Senator Feingold:

In accordance with Public Law 109-115 and Public Law 110-28, I am pleased to submit the Buy American Act Report of the Overseas Private Investment Corporation (OPIC) for FY's 2006 and 2007.

- 1) OPIC made no purchases or articles, materials or supplies that were manufactured outside the United States.
- 2) No waivers were requested or granted by OPIC under the Buy American Act in FY 2006 or FY 2007
- 3) No exceptions were used to purchase articles, materials or supplies that were manufactured outside the United States.
- 4) The total procurement funds spent by OPIC on articles, materials, and supplies manufactured inside the United States during FY 2006 was \$119,345.33 and FY 2007 was \$628,220.36.
- 5) The total procurement funds spent by OPIC on articles, materials, and supplies manufactured outside the United States during FY 2006 and FY 2007 was \$0.
