## SODA ASH IN FEBRUARY 2009

U.S. natural soda ash production in February was 670,000 metric tons (t), $17 \%$ lower than the previous month's production of 806,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The February 2009 production total was the lowest since January 1988 when production was $654,000 \mathrm{t}$. The downturn in production was because of the depressed condition affecting domestic and export sales.

Ending inventories of soda ash for February 2009 were $273,000 \mathrm{t}, 6 \%$ higher than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in February was 2 million metric tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in January 2009 was 384,000 t, 27\% lower than that of January 2008, and ending stocks were $17 \%$ higher.

Exports and imports of soda ash in January 2008 were 423,000 t and 169 t , respectively.

The trends in soda ash statistics for January 2009, compared with those of January 2008, were as follows: production was 13\% lower; imports were $91 \%$ lower; exports were $9 \%$ higher; and apparent consumption, $27 \%$ lower. Imports have dropped dramatically in 2009 compared with those of 2008 because of reduced domestic consumption of soda ash.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.

Also included in this report is Table 5 that shows reported consumption of U.S. soda ash by end use in 2008.

## Note:

The final annual average value for soda ash sales in 2008 was \$122.11 per short ton.
