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DIRECTORY OF PRINCIPAL CONSTRUCTION SAND & GRAVEL PRODUCERS IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2007

A total of 1.23 billion metric tons of construction sand and gravel valued at \$8.6 billion (free on board plant) was reported produced in the United States in 2007 by 4,084 companies with 6,668 active operations and 61 sales/distribution yards. Some companies produced both construction and industrial sand and gravel from the same operation.

Most of the construction sand and gravel produced in 2007 came from operations with output larger than 200,000 metric tons per year; 1,893 operations, representing 28% of all operations, produced 77% of the total tonnage.

The 10 leading producing States were, in descending order of tonnage, California, Texas, Arizona, Michigan, Colorado, Minnesota, Washington, Utah, Ohio, and Wisconsin. Their combined production accounted for about 52% of the U.S. total.

The 10 leading sand and gravel companies accounted for 23% of the total production in the United States and are listed in table 1. The companies listed in table 1 are not included in table 2 when the company is not a leading producer in a given State.

These 10 companies had a total of 644 active operations with 31 sales/distribution yards.

The 10 leading pits/yards and the owner companies, in descending order of total output of sand and gravel, were the following:

These 10 plants accounted for about 3% of the total output of sand and gravel in the United States. The plants listed above are not included in table 2 if the company is not a leading producer for that State.

The leading construction sand and gravel producers in each State in 2007 and their total number of active operations and sales yards are listed in table 2. Sales yards, defined as fixed locations that receive sand and gravel from a distant source to sell at the yard, are included in tables 1 and 2.

The top 100 producers of construction sand and gravel in the United States in 2007, including U.S. Forest Service and the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, are listed in table 3. Companies listed in table 3 may not be listed among the principal producers for a particular State even though they may have a plant in that State.
