## CEMENT IN FEBRUARY 2008

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2007 through the current month.<sup>1</sup> The current report contains extensive revisions to the data for, primarily, northern California and Puerto Rico. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for February 2008 were about 6.3 million metric tons (Mt). This was 7.4% lower than shipments in February 2007 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were 12.6 Mt, down by 8.8% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Florida, Pennsylvania, and Alabama, in descending order) shipped about 43% of the February total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Arizona, and Georgia, in descending order) received about 48% of February's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled about 5.3 Mt, about 9.4% lower than the production in February 2007 (table 4). Year-to-date

production was 11.6 Mt, down by 7.0% compared with the same period in 2007. The leading clinker-producing States (Texas, California, Florida, Alabama, and Pennsylvania, in descending order) produced about 47% of the January total.

Masonry cement shipments in February of about 223,000 metric tons (t) were 23% lower than shipments for February 2007 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were 465,000 t, down by about 26%. The leading consuming States in February, in descending order, were Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia, and these States received about 56% of February's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. February 2008 imports of cement and clinker were about 0.8 Mt, down by about 44% from imports in February 2007. Year-to-date imports were 1.8 Mt, down by almost 42%.
