

# Mineral Industry Surveys

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## CEMENT IN JULY 2008

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2007 through the current month.<sup>1</sup> The current report contains extensive revisions to the data for, primarily, northern California and Puerto Rico. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for July 2008 were about 9.8 million metric tons (Mt). This was about 7% lower than shipments in July 2007 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were 57.0 Mt, down by about 12% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Michigan, Missouri, and Pennsylvania, in descending order) shipped about 36% of the July total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Illinois, and Ohio, in descending order) received about 35% of July's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled about 7.1 Mt, about 6% lower than the production in July 2007 (table 4). Year-to-date production

was 46.5 Mt, down by about 7% compared with that of the same period in 2007. The leading clinker-producing States (Texas, California, Pennsylvania, Alabama, and Florida, in descending order) produced about 42% of the July total.

Masonry cement shipments in July of about 297,000 metric tons were about 24% lower than shipments for July 2007 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were 1.92 Mt, down by about 28% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading consuming States in June, in descending order, were Texas, Florida, California, Georgia, and North Carolina, and these States received about 44% of July's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are likely incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. July 2008 imports of cement and clinker were about 1.1 Mt, down by about 49% from imports in July 2007. Year-to-date imports were 7.3 Mt, down by about 47%.
