Hello.

After reviewing the PPL I have a few questions and comments:

- Is this PPL guideline applicable to underground mines such as Gypsum, Salt, Gold, etc. or just to permissible mines primarily coal?
- The submittal date is given. What is the implementation deadline? Please allow sufficient time for manufacturers to produce the necessary quantities to outfit the 600 + mines or some means of working with the mines to be lenient during the production and installation periods.
- Do pager telephone systems constitute as a viable part of the solution in multiple communication system installations?
- Page 3, 1c – Incoming signal alarm. Does the LED on the Motorola and Kenwood radios meet this requirement?
- Page 3, 1d – Does voice communications meet this requirement?
- Page 6, 4b – Can the tracking tag low power warning be displayed on the surface computer or does it have to be on the tag itself?
