To whom it may concern,

This comment is a suggestion for clarification to a testing specification. On page 2928 of 30 CFR Part 74(f)(2), the following immunity and susceptibility is listed (copied directly from proposed CFR):

“Immunity/Susceptibility: IEC 61000-4 and -6 (Electromagnetic compatibility—Part 4-6: Testing and measurement techniques—Immunity to conducted disturbances, induced by radio-frequency fields). Persons must proceed in accordance with IEC 61000-4 and 6.”

The section that states “IEC 61000-4 and -6” appears that it should be written as “IEC 61000-4-6” to eliminate confusion. Is the intent to test against the entire section of 61000-4 through 61000-6, only sections 61000-4 and 61000-6, or the specific test defined in 61000-4-6? As written, it leads to confusion of depth of testing required and needs clarification. Thank you.
