## **JULY 2004 CONSTRUCTION AT \$997.2 BILLION ANNUAL RATE**

Construction put in place spending during July 2004 was estimated at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$997.2 billion, 0.4 (±1.8) percent above the revised June estimate of \$992.9 billion, according to the U.S. Commerce Department's Census Bureau. The July figure is 9.7 (±2.4) percent above the July 2003 estimate of \$909.4 billion.

During the first 7 months of this year, construction spending amounted to \$550.2 billion, 9.0 (±1.6) percent above the \$504.8 billion for the same period in 2003.

## PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION

Spending on private construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$758.3 billion, 0.4 (±1.8) percent above the revised June estimate of \$755.3 billion. Residential construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$537.5 billion in July, 0.3 (±1.8) percent above the revised June estimate of \$536.1 billion. Nonresidential construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$220.8 billion in July, 0.8 (±1.8) percent above the revised June estimate of \$219.1 billion.

## **PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION**

In July, the estimated seasonally adjusted annual rate of public construction spending was \$238.9 billion, 0.6 (±2.6) percent above the revised June estimate of \$237.6 billion. Educational construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$63.8 billion, 1.5 (±3.5) percent below the revised June estimate of \$64.8 billion. Highway construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$65.7 billion, 1.8 (±6.9) percent below the revised June estimate of \$66.9 billion.

August 2004 data will be released on October 1, 2004 at 10:00 AM EDT.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

In interpreting changes in the statistics in this release, note that month-to-month changes in seasonally adjusted statistics often show movements which may be irregular. It may take 2 months to establish an underlying trend for total construction and as long as 8 months for specific categories of construction.

The statistics in this release are estimated from several sources and surveys and are subject to sampling variability as well as nonsampling errors including bias and variance from response, nonreporting, and undercoverage. Estimates of the standard errors are provided in Table 3. Whenever a statement such as "2.3 (±3.1) percent above" appears in the text, this indicates the range (-0.8 to +5.4 percent) in which the actual percent change is likely to have occurred. All ranges given are 90 percent confidence intervals. If the range contains zero, it is uncertain whether there was an increase or decrease; that is, the change was not statistically significant. For any comparison cited without a confidence interval, the change is statistically significant. Statistics for the current month are preliminary estimates subject to revision in following months as additional data become available. The average absolute percent changes from preliminary estimate to first revision for the major seasonally adjusted components are as follows: total construction, 0.7 percent; private construction, 0.6 percent; and public construction, 2.0 percent.
