DECEMBER 2004 CONSTRUCTION AT \$1,031.8 BILLION ANNUAL RATE

Construction put in place spending during December 2004 was estimated at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$1,031.8 billion, 1.1 (±1.4) percent above the revised November estimate of \$1,020.8 billion, according to the U.S. Commerce Department's Census Bureau. The December figure is 8.7 (±2.2) percent above the December 2003 estimate of \$948.9 billion.

The value of construction spending in 2004 was \$998.4 billion, 9.0 (±1.4) percent above the \$915.7 billion spent in 2003.

PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION

Spending on private construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$789.0 billion, 0.9 ± 1.6) percent above the revised November estimate of \$782.3 billion. Residential construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$559.8 billion in December, 0.7 ± 1.3) percent above the revised November estimate of \$555.8 billion. Nonresidential construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$229.2 billion in December, 1.2 ± 1.6) percent above the revised November estimate of \$226.5 billion.

The value of private construction in 2004 was \$764.9 billion, 10.9 (±2.1) percent above the \$690.0 billion in 2003. Residential construction in 2004 was \$542.7 billion, 14.0 (±2.1) percent above the 2003 figure of \$476.1 billion and nonresidential construction was \$222.2 billion, 3.9 (±2.1) percent above the \$213.9 billion in 2003.

PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION

In December, the estimated seasonally adjusted annual rate of public construction spending was \$242.8 billion, 1.8 (±2.1) percent above the revised November estimate of \$238.4 billion. Educational construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$66.2 billion, 1.7 (±3.2) percent above the revised November estimate of \$65.1 billion. Highway construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$68.1 billion, 3.2 (±5.4) percent above the revised November estimate of \$66.0 billion.

The value of public construction in 2004 was \$233.5 billion, 3.4 (±1.8) percent above \$225.7 billion in 2003. Education construction in 2004 was \$63.1 billion, 3.8 (±3.5) percent above the \$60.8 billion in 2003 and highway construction was \$65.0 billion, 3.7 (±3.8) percent above the \$62.7 billion in 2003.

January 2005 data will be released on March 1, 2005 at 10:00 AM EST.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

In interpreting changes in the statistics in this release, note that month-to-month changes in seasonally adjusted statistics often show movements which may be irregular. It may take 2 months to establish an underlying trend for total construction and as long as 8 months for specific categories of construction.

The statistics in this release are estimated from several sources and surveys and are subject to sampling variability as well as nonsampling errors including bias and variance from response, nonreporting, and undercoverage. Estimates of the standard errors are provided in Table 3. Whenever a statement such as "2.3 (±3.1) percent above" appears in the text, this indicates the range (-0.8 to +5.4 percent) in which the actual percent change is likely to have occurred. All ranges given are 90 percent confidence intervals. If the range contains zero, it is uncertain whether there was an increase or decrease; that is, the change was not statistically significant. Statistics for the current month are preliminary estimates subject to revision in following months as additional data become available. The average absolute percent changes from preliminary estimate to first revision for the major seasonally adjusted components are as follows: total construction, 0.7 percent; private construction, 0.6 percent; and public construction, 2.0 percent.
