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## DIRECTORY OF PRINCIPAL CONSTRUCTION AGGREGATES PRODUCERS IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2007

A total of 2.83 billion metric tons of construction aggregates valued at \$22.5 billion, free on board at plant, was reported produced in the United States in 2007 by 5,200 companies with more than 10,000 operations, 3,700 active quarries, and 8,600 active pits. These companies also reported sales of construction aggregates from 254 sales yards.

The 10 leading producing States were, in descending order of tonnage, Texas, California, Pennsylvania, Florida, Ohio, Illinois, Arizona, Missouri, Georgia, and Indiana, which accounted for 45% of the total output of construction aggregates.

These 10 companies listed in table 1 with a total of 924 active quarries and 661 active pits accounted for 37% of the total output of construction aggregates in the United States. In addition, these companies operated 204 sales/distribution yards. The companies listed in table 1 are not included in table 2 when the company is not a leading producer in a given State.

These 10 quarries accounted for 5% of the total output of crushed stone in the United States.

These 10 plants accounted for 3% of the total output of sand and gravel in the United States.

The leading construction aggregates producers in each State and their number of active crushed stone quarries and sand and gravel pits are listed in table 2. Companies listed in table 3 may not be listed among the principal producers for a particular State even though they may have a pit or quarry in that State.
