TRANSPARENCY RECYCLING

Don't throw out your used overhead transparencies!
RECYCLE them for **REUSE**. It's Easy!

Follow these simple procedures:

- 1.) **COLLECT** used transparencies to be recycled.
- 2.) **SEPARATE** the transparencies from ringed binders, plastic or paper folders, envelopes, and/or files.
- 3.) **PLACE** the transparencies (only) into an intra-laboratory mail envelope.
- 4.) **SEND** the envelope to:
Erica Carter-Bean, Building 201, 2H-05. Erica will prepare a transfer order. The transparencies will be sent to the **3M Recycle Program**.

Other Information

- Keeping your transparencies out of the trash, helps us meet our performance standards.
- The transparencies are made of polyester, which can be recycled into a variety of everyday items: fiber fill for chairs and carpeting, automotive products, more transparency film, insulation, and many other useful products.
