Types of Acceptable Batteries

- ► Alkaline flashlights
- ► Lead sealed, non-automotive
- ► Lithium cameras and pagers
- ▶ Nickel and Nickel Cadmium laptop computers and cell phones
- ➤ Silver Oxide/Button Cell watches
- ► Zinc Carbon flashlights

Program Procedures:

- <u>Batteries from Radiological Areas are prohibited from this program.</u>
- Batteries from Home are prohibited from this program.
- <u>Apply Tape to Battery Terminals (to avoid electrical short circuit).</u>
- Batteries should be placed in the "Battery Collection Container"
