Types of Acceptable Batteries

- ▶ Alkaline – flashlights
- ▶ Lead – sealed, non-automotive
- ▶ Lithium – cameras and pagers
- ▶ Nickel and Nickel Cadmium – laptop computers and cell phones
- ▶ Silver Oxide/Button Cell - watches
- ▶ Zinc Carbon – flashlights

Program Procedures:

- **Batteries from Radiological Areas are prohibited from this program.**
- **Batteries from Home are prohibited from this program.**
- **Apply Tape to Battery Terminals (to avoid electrical short circuit).**
- Batteries should be placed in the “Battery Collection Container”

- Do not transport any leaking or damaged batteries. If you have leaking or damaged batteries, contact your Environmental Compliance REP for proper disposal methods.
