

Are you the picture of health?

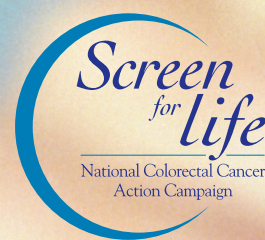
