## **5 FAH-1 H-1011 GENERAL**

(CT:CH-19; 7-27-2007)

- a. *The Department uses* Diplomatic Notes for correspondence between the U.S. Government and a foreign government (see 5 FAH-1 H-600).
- b. Letters may be used in correspondence with foreign government officials except when diplomatic notes are appropriate (see 5 FAH-1 H-400).
- c. A consular post conducts direct correspondence with local officials or their district. In the absence of a diplomatic representative, a consular post official may correspond directly with the central government of the country in which the district is located.
- d. This chapter contains guidelines for anyone in the Department responsible for corresponding with foreign governments in an official capacity. It also *provides links* to official current listing of the countries, official designations, and capitals of the world. *This chapter concludes with* specific instructions regarding the use of "United States of America".
