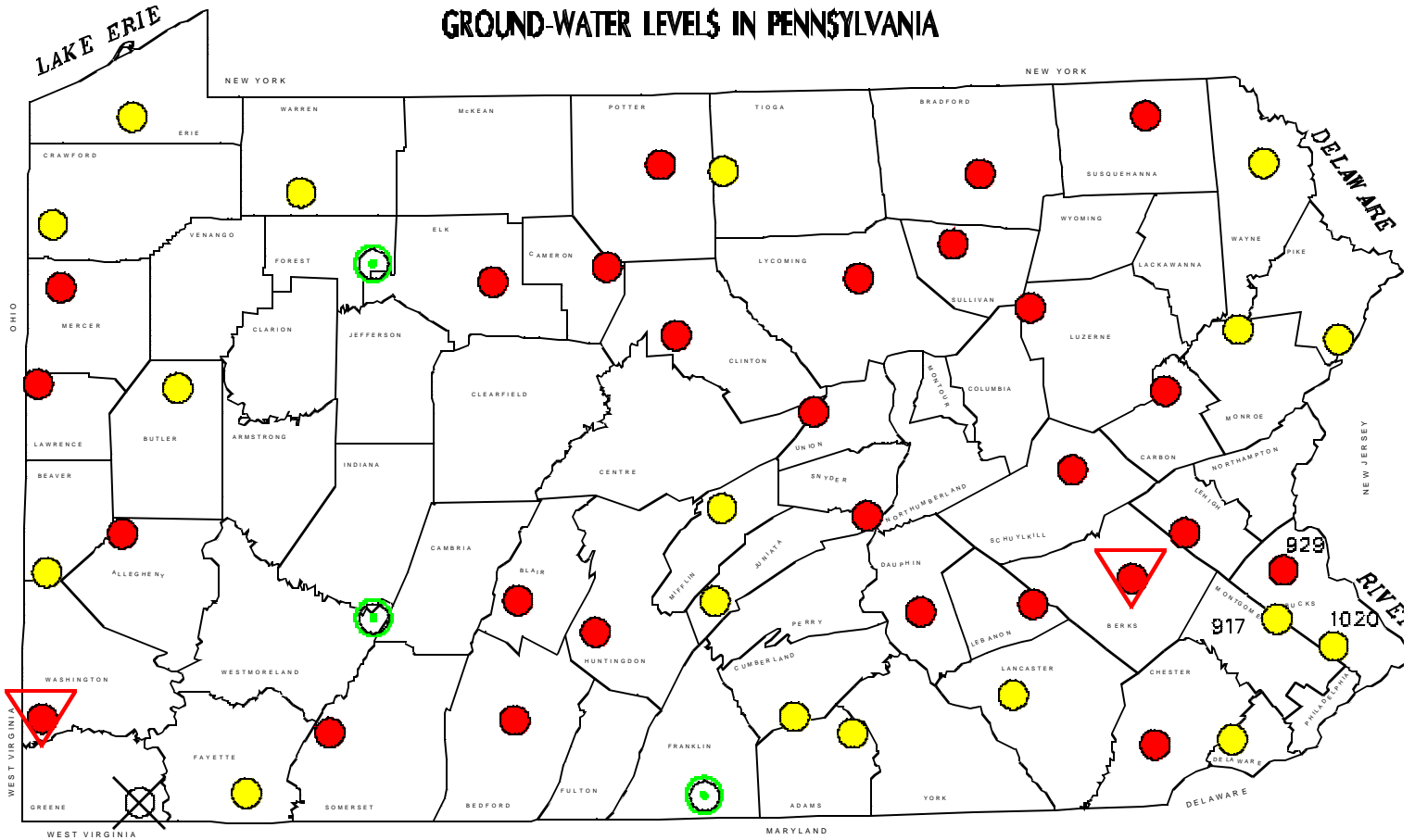


GROUND-WATER LEVELS IN PENNSYLVANIA

MEAN WATER LEVELS IN OBSERVATION WELLS
