Dear Registered Buyer:

If you are a Shoreside Processor that has, or will, received and purchased halibut and/or sablefish from an Individual Fishing Quota (IFQ) permitholder between October 1, 2007 and September 30, 2008, you must fill out the enclosed IFQ Registered Buyer Ex-vessel Value and Volume Report.

For your convenience, we are providing a report generated from our records that indicates the total amount of IFQ halibut and/or sablefish that has been landed under your Registered Buyer permit to date. Please use this report to reconcile your records and complete your IFQ Registered Buyer Ex-vessel Value and Volume Report (Value/Volume Report). Please note that CDQ landings are not included on this report and *should not* be included in the Value Volume Report you submit to our office.

This report must be completed and submitted no later than October 15, 2008. Failure to submit this report in a timely manner is a violation of recordkeeping and reporting requirements under 50 CFR 679.5(l)(7)(i). You may submit this report using one of the following methods:
