Invitation to Speaker

The BSSRS (and we have asked British Pugwash if they would be co-sponsor) is planning a meeting on the Social Impact of Modern Biology. This would not only deal fairly thoroughly with the scientific aspects (in particular with molecular genetics) but would also try to put these in a wide perspective.
