Utilization of Belt Air and Fire Retardant Properties of Belt Materials - Comments on Proposed Rules

- 1. Pennsylvania is the 4th largest coal producing state yet there were no public meetings held in Pennsylvania. There should be public meetings held in Pennsylvania for all rule making issues.
- 2. The 1992 study recognized the need for upgrading the standards and over 15 years later, no improvements have been made. The flame resistant standards for conveyor belting should include a requirement to address technology improvements that are revisited on a periodic basis. This will ensure that the mine belting flame resistance requirements stays current with current technology.
- 3. Drive belt pulley lagging should also be included to ensure it meets the same fire resistance / retardant standards required under this proposal for conveyor belting.
- 4. The proposed regulations in section 14.4 b2 describe a "similar" belting but do not include what variance in compounds are acceptable for belting to be similar. This should be included in the proposed rule.
