TRUSTEE COUNCIL RESOLUTION 08-1 ADOPTED 1/15, 2008

MONTROSE TRUSTEE COUNCIL RESOLUTION REGARDING Funding for the Montrose Settlements Restoration Program: Calendar Year 2008 Budget, Part 1

- 1. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration; the State of California acting through the State Lands Commission, the Department of Parks & Recreation and the Department of Fish & Game; and the Department of the Interior, acting through the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service and the U.S. Park Service are the natural resource trustees (Trustees) for natural resources injured by releases of DDT and PCBs into the Southern California Bight.
- 2. Sums recovered in the civil action United States, et al. v.

 Montrose Chemical Corp., et al., No. CV 90-3122-R (C.D. Cal. 1990)

 are being held in the Department of the Interior Natural Resource

 Damage Assessment and Restoration Fund (DOI Restoration Fund) and
 the registry account administered by the U.S. District Court for
 the Central District of California.
- The Trustees have entered into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) that establishes a Trustee Council (Montrose Trustee Council) composed of one voting member for each trustee agency. Under the terms of that MOU, the Montrose Trustee Council is authorized to disburse funds for activities related to the damage assessment and restoration process.
- 4. The Trustees approve planned expenditures of \$5,092,008.00 for budget year 2008, which extends from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008. Included in these planned expenditures are the Trustee Council operating costs; operating costs for the MSRP office in Long Beach; costs associated with fish, seabird, and peregrine restoration; and the public outreach and education activities for the year. 2008 planned expenditures for each trustee agency are as follows:

\$2,586,731.00 for National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration \$1,915,724.00 for United States Fish and Wildlife Service \$459,037.00 for National Park Service \$65,388.00 for California Department of Fish and Game \$36,674.00 for California State Lands Commission \$8,000.00 for California Department of Parks and Recreation \$20,454.00 for Department of the Interior

5. The Montrose Trustee Council resolves unanimously to authorize as advance funding for 2008 the disbursement of \$4,356,874.00 from the DOI Restoration Fund as follows:

\$2,348,985.00 for National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration \$1,615,724.00 for United States Fish and Wildlife Service \$359,037.00 for National Park Service

\$0.00 for California Department of Fish and Game
\$4,674.00 for California State Lands Commission
\$8,000.00 for California Department of Parks and Recreation
\$20,454.00 for Department of the Interior

- 6. These disbursements reflect the planned expenditures identified in paragraph 4, less the estimated funds still remaining with each trustee agency from prior funding.
- 7. Each trustee agency receiving advance funding for 2008 shall submit by July 31, 2008 to the program manager a summary report of estimated expenditures for the first part of the calendar year. This expenditure report is for program management purposes and need not include supporting documentation. Each trustee agency shall submit a full and final cost documentation package on July 31, 2009, including supporting documentation (e.g. timesheets, travel vouchers, and receipts).
- 8. Each trustee agency shall submit a full and final cost documentation package for the 2007 budget year on July 31, 2008. Disbursement of 2009 advance funding to each trustee agency will be contingent upon the Trustee Council's acceptance of the final annual cost documentation package submitted by each trustee agency for the 2007 budget year.
- 9. Funds that are not completely exhausted by the end of a budget year may be used to cover execution of the approved program element in a subsequent budget year or, with additional Trustee Council approval, applied to other Montrose Settlements Restoration Program tasks.
- 10. This Resolution does not limit the number of additional advance funding requests that can be made during the time period required to complete restoration.
- 11. The effective date of the Resolution shall be the date on which the last trustee signs this document.
