3 MR. BAKER: Okay. We'll go ahead and start. My name
4 is Greg Baker, and I'm with the Montrose Settlements
5 Restoration Program. And I will start by making the
6 introduction.

7 We have a court reporter here today, and so I've
8 asked that the people who want to make some comments or
9 questions during the public comment section go ahead and
10 fill out a card so we make sure we have everyone's name
11 correctly.

12 Also here tonight is Annie Little from the
13 program, Dave Witting, and we have Milena Viljoen in the
14 background, and Tim Boyce is a council member. And
15 Julie Yamamoto is here from Department of Fish and Game,
16 and Kate Faulkner is here from National Park Services.
17 Thank you for sitting in this evening.

18 What we would like to do is, before we get into
19 the questions and comments and things, is to get some
20 background on the restoration plan. So, if you could hold
21 your comments and questions until the end.

22 (Brief Presentation.)

23 MR. BAKER: So I think that's it. This is the fourth
24 of our four public meetings, and what I'd like to do is go
25 ahead and move from our presentation part of our meeting to

1 our questions and comments part of the meeting.

2 I have a couple of cards that I've gotten filled
3 out so far, and for the sake of making a record of this,
4 I'd like to ask that anyone else beyond these first two
5 people who would like to speak, you know, go ahead and fill
6 out a card.

7 So I'll go ahead and start with Kristen Lambert.

8 MS. LAMBERT: Hello, I'm Kristen Lambert, I'm 14 years
9 old, I live in Malibu, and I'm president of Malibu Middle
10 School.

11 I've seen our national bird once in my life, and
12 that was in Catalina. When I was polling and talking to
13 some people at school, it was estimated that one-third of
14 Malibu Middle School has seen a bald eagle in the wild.
15 And that means that about two-thirds of kids ages 11 to 15
16 in Malibu have not seen a live bald eagle, and that's
17 America's national bird.

18 Not only are we preserving bald eagles, we're
19 saving the island foxes, as bald eagles will help in the
20 protection of that, and it's an exceedingly endangered
21 species.

22 In six hours at school, I collected 221
23 signatures of students and adults alike all wanting to save
24 these innocent birds.

25 When I was eight, my family packed up and drove

1 to Central California for a two-day guided hike in search
2 of bald eagles, and you know what we saw? Quails.

3 I remember the one time I did see a bald eagle,
4 though. That was -- my father and I were kayaking in
5 Catalina harbor, and he grabbed my arm and pointed and
6 said, "There, that is a bald eagle." And sure enough,
7 sitting up on the ledge of the cliff, there it was, the
8 symbol of America.

9 Please, for me, my peers, and my children,
10 continue the funding of this important project. So please,
11 Alternative No. 3. Thank you.

12 MR. BAKER: Thank you very much. Okay. Go ahead,
13 Carl.

14 MR. LAMBERT: Well, I'm the proud father of
15 Kristen Lambert, and, you know, my name is Carl Lambert. I
16 live in Malibu.

17 And I am also the president of the Tuna Club
18 Foundation in Catalina, and I am the past director of the
19 NCMC, which is the National Coalition for Marine
20 Conservation. I'm also a member of the Catalina
21 Conservancy, and, you know, I would really like to
22 encourage you to continue with the funding in
23 Santa Catalina.

24 Catalina Island is a magical place where it's a
25 blend of paradise for the wildlife. You've got 42,000

1 acres which were set aside in 1972 never to be touched.
2 Now, it also has a unique component to that conservation
3 bend and that is that over a million visitors a year go to
4 Avalon. And I would venture to say at least another half
5 again as many go to the island and visit by going by boat,
6 they kayak, I've seen people take jet skis over to
7 Catalina. Now, you don't see that in the northern
8 Channel Islands.

9 I love the northern Channel Islands. I dove
10 there. I've fished there. I've been on the shore. It's
11 beautiful. I've been with my daughter. We went up to
12 Santa Cruz, and we did a kid's weekend on a boat, and then
13 we hiked through Cata- -- Santa Cruz Island, and it's truly
14 magical. I've been on all but the Navy Islands in our
15 chain.

16 And so, you know, I -- I grew up on the
17 East Coast, and I was a member of the Indian Guides with my
18 father. I was Little Eagle Feather, my father was Bald
19 Eagle. Tells you something about my father. But, anyway,
20 you know, I looked on the Appalachian Trail. I looked in
21 the Nukuaeta Islands.

22 I looked all over the place for bald eagles all
23 my life, and it wasn't until the mid to late '80s that I
24 saw my first bald eagle, and it was at Santa Catalina
25 island on the west end. And I can close my eyes, and I can

1 see the bird flying, and it flew around. I saw it land.
2 It was truly magical. I finally got a chance to see it.

3 And then I can remember another time when I was
4 on a fishing boat and nearby was another sport fishing boat
5 with all these guys that paid 25 bucks for the day to come
6 over to fish on Catalina island, and they're all fishing
7 and somebody drops over an injured mackerel, and it's
8 there, and before that, I also seen another bald eagle, and
9 low and behold -- and other people had seen the eagle --
10 and, you know, to see one soaring overhead, you know the
11 difference between a bald eagle and a seagull. I mean,
12 they are super impressive.

13 And there this fish goes, you know, swimming off,
14 and this bald eagle came down, swooped down, grabbed the
15 mackerel, and took off, and flew away. And I can tell you,
16 and I was a couple hundred yards away, the whoops and cries
17 and the hollers from the people that saw that. They
18 were -- they put down their fishing rods. They were
19 applauding. It was spectacular.

20 Then another time, one, as my daughter mentioned,
21 I had the privilege of showing her her first bald eagle.
22 There he was perched up on a cliff at Cap Harbor. And then
23 another time, I was in Catalina Harbor working on the pins
24 for the white sea bass. They have -- the brood stock is
25 there and the hatchery, the fish come in there, and, again,

1 I had the privilege of seeing another bald eagle.

2 And it must -- it was about a year and a half
3 ago. I was visiting a friend who lives over at
4 Hamilton Cove, and Hamilton Cove, probably not the most
5 beautiful thing in the world, maybe to some, but it's this
6 large condo development on Catalina Island. But as I
7 was -- just before I went down the steps to go toward the
8 unit, I saw couple of people coming down hurriedly from the
9 mountain coming down the street, and they were going,
10 "There's an eagle. There's an eagle."

11 And we went up, and sure enough, and I've got
12 pictures of this eagle, maybe it was a little bit from
13 afar, I was about 300 yards, but there was a bald eagle on
14 the island. And that is what it's about.

15 You need to have a little human action,
16 interaction with the eagles, because it's wonderful to
17 introduce them to the northern Channel Islands. And I
18 applaud you for that. I think it's fabulous. And I
19 understand that it might be a little more expensive to do
20 it down in the -- Catalina.

21 And I really wish you'd put up one of the
22 pictures here that you had earlier of -- that showed the
23 Channel Islands chain, because, if you look at it, most of
24 the DDT went right down near Catalina Island, and Catalina
25 bore the brunt of it.

1 And so I would submit to you today that
2 Catalina Island should have a bigger portion, because they
3 need it. And I -- I agree, you know, it's -- it might be
4 cheaper up here to do it, but, then again, you don't have
5 the human interaction. And one of the great things about
6 being an American is being able to see the national bird.

7 And I can tell you that a lot of people come to
8 Catalina saying, "Where are the bald eagles? How do I get
9 into the interior to see them?" And, you know, kayakers
10 tell me about them, people talk about them at night, at the
11 nightclubs, anywhere, "I saw an eagle today."

12 I mean, that is important. That's the good news,
13 you know. The bad news is the crime against humanity that
14 occurred at Montrose. And it was probably either the board
15 that said, "We got to get rid of this stuff." And, you
16 know, it's amazing what you remember when you're a kid.

17 But in the '60s, I remember seeing a cartoon.
18 And it's Archie, I'm dating myself. Most of you probably
19 haven't seen the comic strip, Archie. It was in the --
20 well, it was the Washington Star at the time. And it
21 shows, "Well, I found this pad of DDT in my garage. What
22 do I do with it?"

23 And they said, "Well, we can't put it down the
24 sewer. We can't flush it down the toilet. We can't," you
25 know, "throw it away because it'll ruin the dump. What do

1 we do with it?"

2 And finally Archie and the next friend took and
3 encased it in concrete and, you know, put -- made it into a
4 bird bath on top. And it was, you know, that kind of
5 creativity, and, you know, it stuck with me. You know,
6 what is this DDT? And then low and behold I move out to
7 Southern California, and I'm close, you know, very near
8 ground zero of, you know, one of the great natural -- or
9 great disasters. And so I would say that what they did was
10 criminal.

11 And we have an opportunity. We got a fund, and
12 we have an opportunity to right that wrong. And I think
13 that it is most appropriate to really support the Catalina
14 bald eagle restoration project and recognize the
15 conservancy doesn't just take the eggs from the local
16 eagles, which I understand are defective.

17 But they release seven -- they've hatched 17 of
18 those eggs. But, additionally, over the last 20 years, the
19 Catalina Island Conservancy has released 80 eagles into the
20 environment. They bring eggs down from San Francisco Zoo
21 and other zoos, and they hatch them here. They give them
22 to the birds, and they are released wild. That's 80 birds
23 for \$200,000 a year?

24 I mean, if you look at it, that's less than
25 \$50,000 a bird. And, you know, for \$50,000, for the price

1 of an SUV, you can have a bald eagle freed Catalina where
2 millions of people can see them and have the opportunity to
3 interact with them. And so -- and I don't want to sound
4 like a crackpot or being very extremely cynical, but I see
5 this is about money.

6 I see the fact that you've got alternative one,
7 two, and three. And looks like you focused on two and
8 three. Two eliminates Catalina Island, and I see, with all
9 due respect, I see a lot of green shirts here, and you guys
10 have the northern Channel Islands. So I can understand the
11 desire to put and reintroduce the birds into Northern
12 Calif- -- in the northern islands.

13 But also recognize that you've got golden eagles.
14 Golden eagles compete with bald eagles. And one of the
15 nice things about -- another side effect of that
16 competition is that, because the bald eagles are so well
17 entrenched in Catalina Island, they keep the golden eagle
18 out. And by keeping the golden eagle out, that protects
19 the Catalina Island fox.

20 And the Catalina Island fox is a cute little guy.
21 You see a picture of him right there, behind Greg there,
22 and it is a small little guy, not much bigger than a house
23 cat and prime prey for the larger eagles, for the golden
24 eagles.

25 And so that's one of the problems that you have

1 in the Northern Channel Islands is the decimation of the
2 fox by the golden eagles. But if the bald eagles in
3 Catalina can no longer breed, then they will probably
4 leave. And if they leave, the golden eagles come in, the
5 foxes, which is on the federal endangered species list,
6 gets decimated.

7 So I would encourage the people that at the
8 trustee council, and if you could, please, underline this.
9 You have to support version Alternative No. 3 for the
10 preservation of the bald eagle in Catalina for, not just
11 our generation, but the generations to come. Thank you.

12 MR. BAKER: Okay. Thanks, Carl.

13 Do we have any other -- any other questions or
14 comments?

15 What we could do is, I'll mention that the public
16 comment period -- the public comments entered into the
17 record, we will be responding to these comments and taking
18 them into consideration and be happy to just go ahead and
19 end the formal meeting. And anyone who wants to talk a
20 little more afterwards, feel free, we'll be here.

21 So thank you all for coming.
