By Order dated July 20, 2000, this Court granted plaintiffs' motion to enjoin commercial groundfish trawl fishing within the waters of Steller sea lion critical habitat in the Bering Sea/Aleutian Islands and the Gulf of Alaska regions west of 144 degrees west longitude, effective August 8, 2000 at noon Pacific time. See docket no. 421. The Court further ordered plaintiffs to file a proposed form of injunction by July 28, 2000, and defendant National Marine Fisheries Service and defendant-intervenors representing the fishing industry to file any

1 objections to the proposed form of injunction by August 4, 2000. Having now reviewed the  
2 submissions of the parties, and pursuant to this Court's Order of July 20, 2000, the Court hereby  
3 enters the following injunction:

4 All groundfish trawl fishing, as the term "fishing" is defined at 16 U.S.C. § 1802(15) and  
5 authorized pursuant to the Fishery Management Plans for the Bering Sea/Aleutian Islands and  
6 Gulf of Alaska, within Steller sea lion critical habitat west of 144 degrees west longitude, as  
such critical habitat is defined by regulation, is hereby ENJOINED.

7 This injunction is limited to fishing within federally regulated waters. The injunction  
8 shall take effect at noon Pacific time, Tuesday, August 8, 2000, and shall remain in effect until  
further order of this Court.

9 IT IS SO ORDERED.
