U.S. Coral Reef Task Force International Year of the Reef 2008

Action Plan Adopted August 23, 2007

Vision

The U.S. Coral Reef Task Force (USCRTF) will utilize the International Year of the Reef platform, and 2008 as the 10-year anniversary of the USCRTF to strengthen and enhance the existing mission, role, and activities of the USCRTF.

The USCRTF was established to lead, coordinate, and strengthen U.S. government actions to conserve coral reef ecosystems, both domestic and international, as called for under the Executive Order for the Protection of Coral Reefs. IYOR 2008 and the 10-year anniversary provide an avenue for the USCRTF members, through individual and collective efforts and activities, to promote the following elements:

- Enhance implementation of the Task Force mission and goals.
- Increase/Broaden participation, partnerships, and collaborative action.
- **Communicate** the issues, threats, and actions required for coral reef conservation, along with the mission and goals of the USCRTF, individual members and collectively.

Leadership Role for the U.S. Coral Reef Task Force

- Support local, regional and international activities that assist in meeting the goals of the Task Force to conserve coral reef ecosystems domestically and internationally, engaging partners where possible
- Promote involvement by all partners and facilitate brainstorming sessions
- Plan and facilitate Task Force hosted activities internationally, nationally, regionally, and locally
- Develop a Renewed Call to Action to supplement and update the National Action Plan, starting with a gap analysis of which goals have not been met and should be targeted for greater action.
- Support efforts of the International Coral Reef Initiative (ICRI) and the USG Co-Chair of the ICRI Secretariat

Participation by U.S. Coral Reef Task Force Members

To facilitate and enhance Task Force member participation the following information or items should be identified:

• **Funding** – Identify Task Force member agency and other partner funding to support the IYoR effort.

- **Points of Contact** Identify, for each target audience, individuals from member agencies that can serve as a resource and participate in IYoR as needed (public relations, legislative affairs, education, etc.).
- **Products** Compile a list of specific agency reports and/or products that are due or planned for distribution in 2008.
- **Priorities** Identify Task Force Member agency priority projects/efforts planned for 2008.
- **Events** Create a calendar of events and activities currently planned for 2008 (outreach, workshops, trainings, other).
