FSM Protected Areas Network (FSM-PAN)

Mission: The FSM will have more extensive, diverse, and higher quality of marine freshwater, and terrestrial ecosystems, which meet human needs and aspirations fairly, preserve and utilize traditional knowledge and practices....full ecosystem protection

Goals:

1. Establish a systematic network to protect, conserve and sustainably manage the full and functional representation of the FSM's marine, freshwater, and terrestrial ecosystems under a national protected areas network
2. Complete a comprehensive sustainable finance plan for the national system of protected areas
