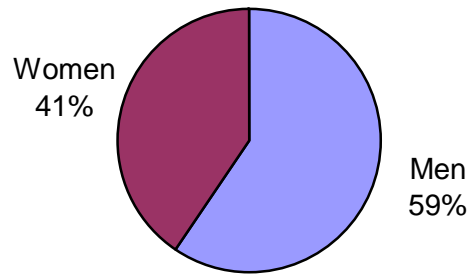

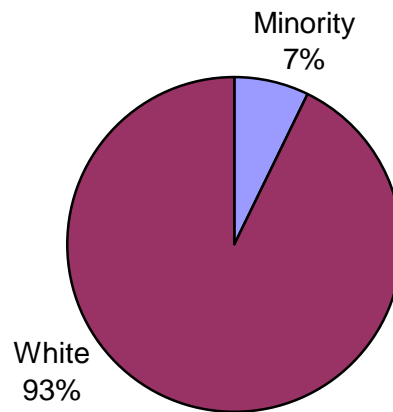

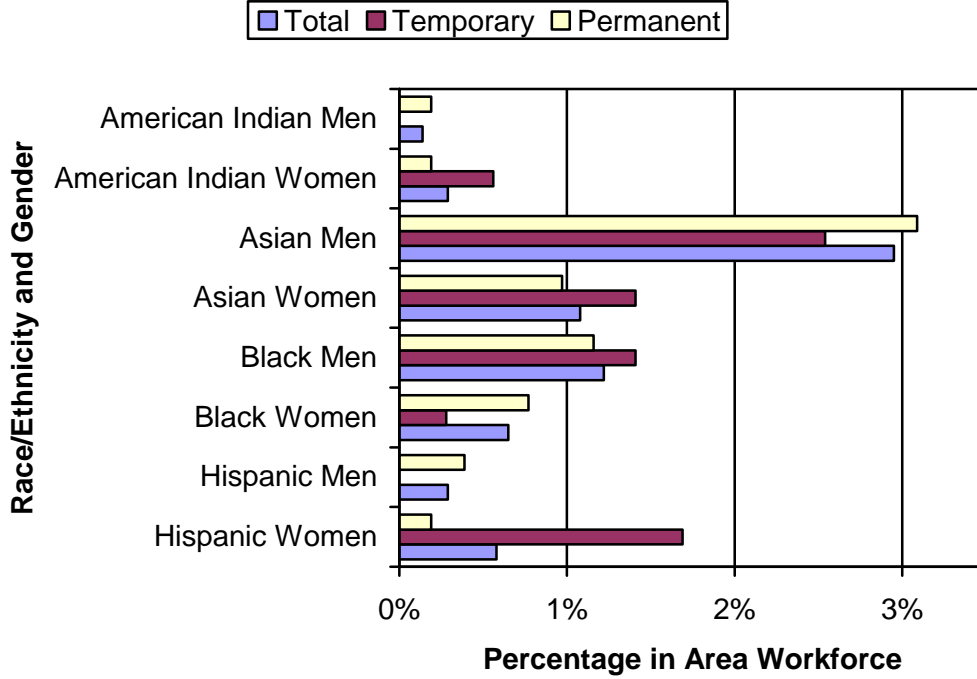
Gender Distribution in Total Area Workforce



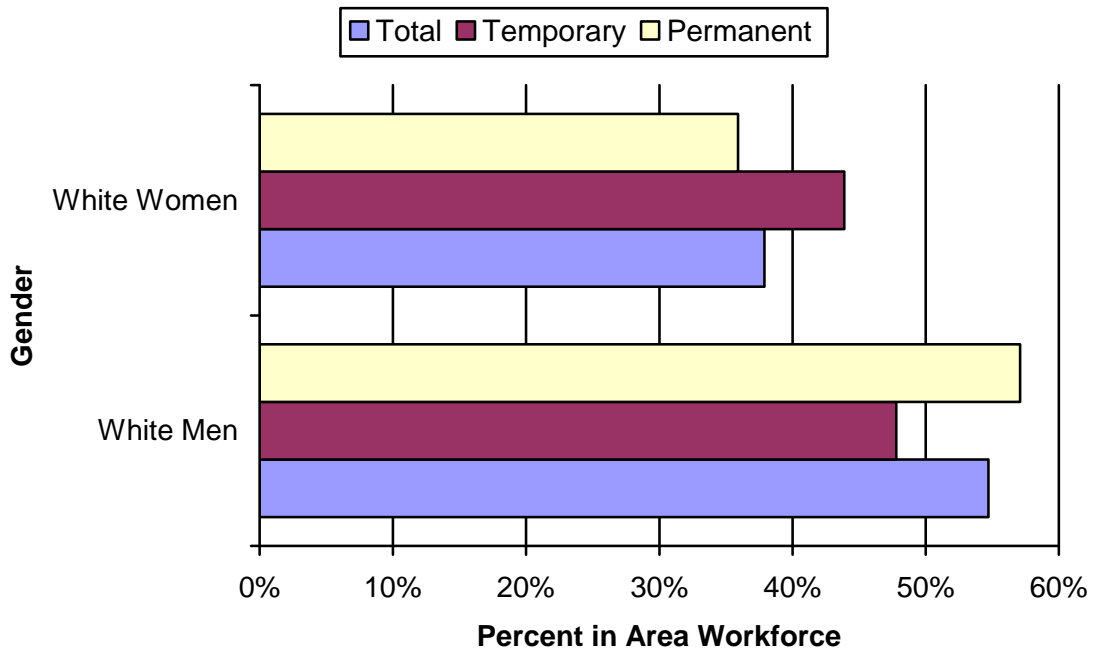
Minority and White Participation in Total Area Workforce



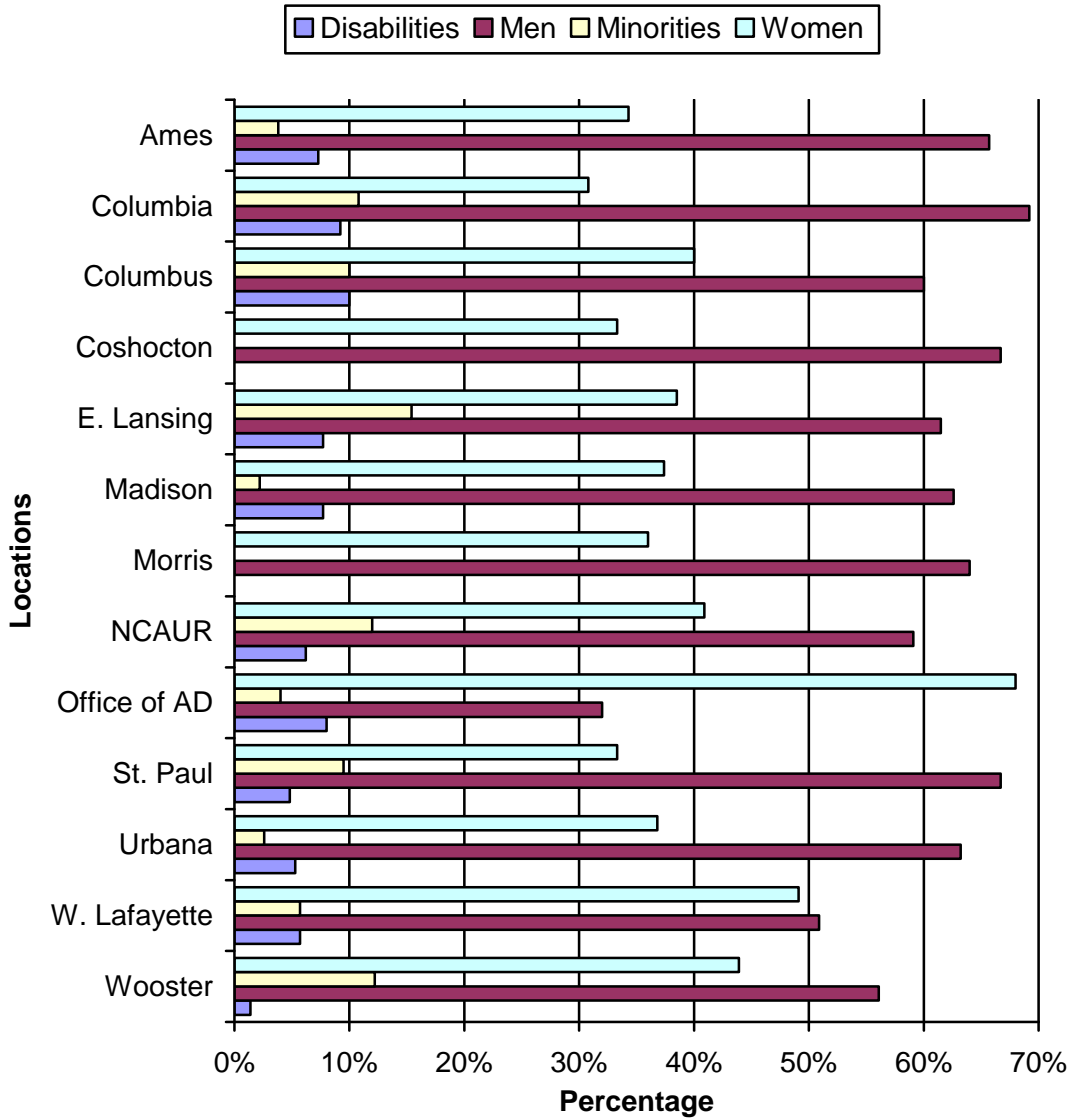
Minority Participation by Race/Ethnicity and Gender in Area Workforce



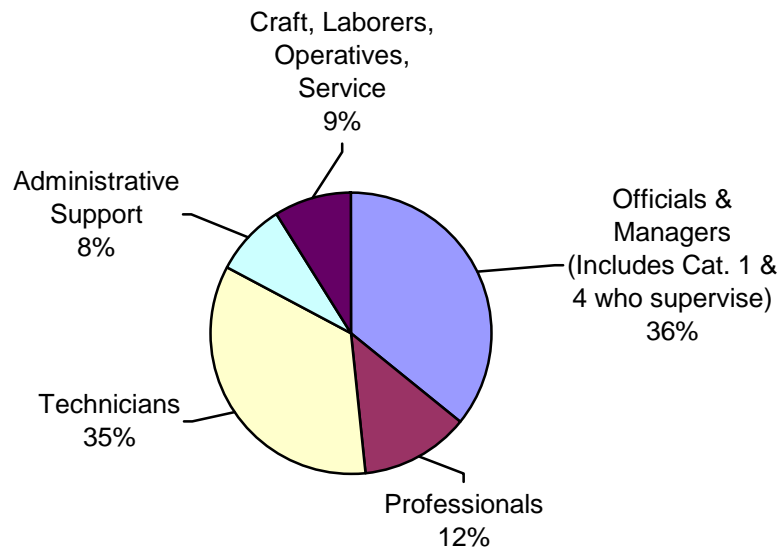
White Participation by Gender in Area Workforce



Representation by Location of Permanent Workforce

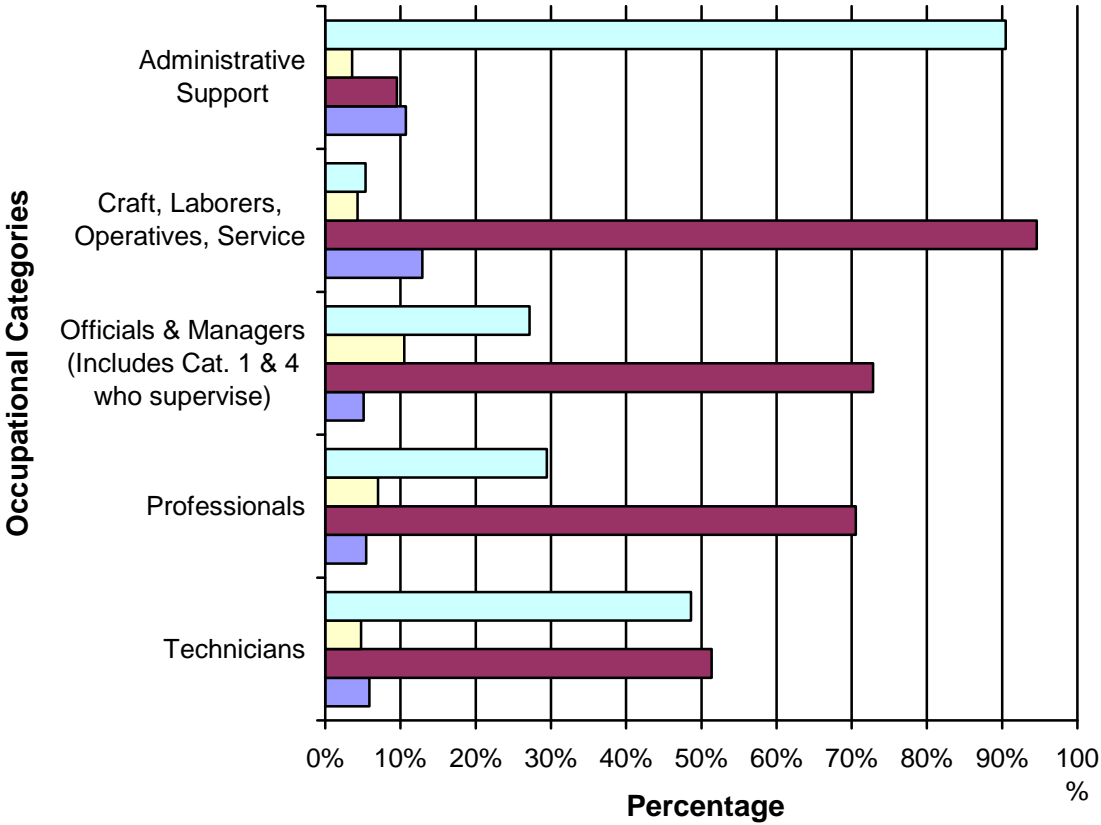


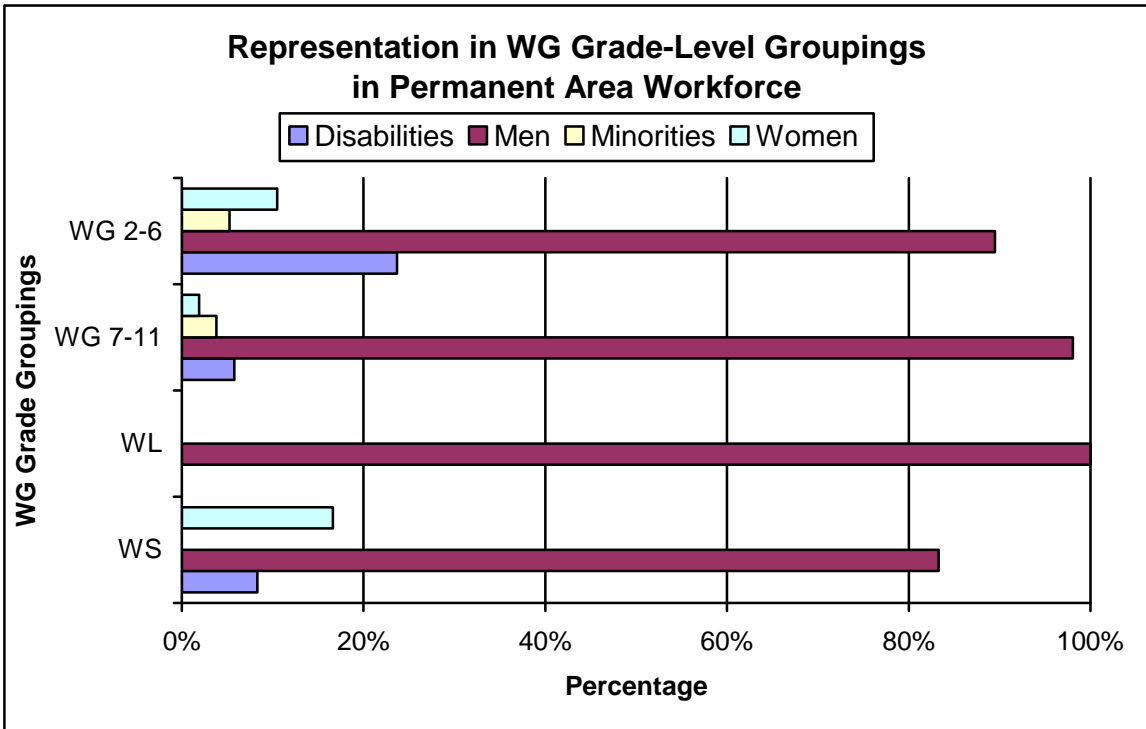
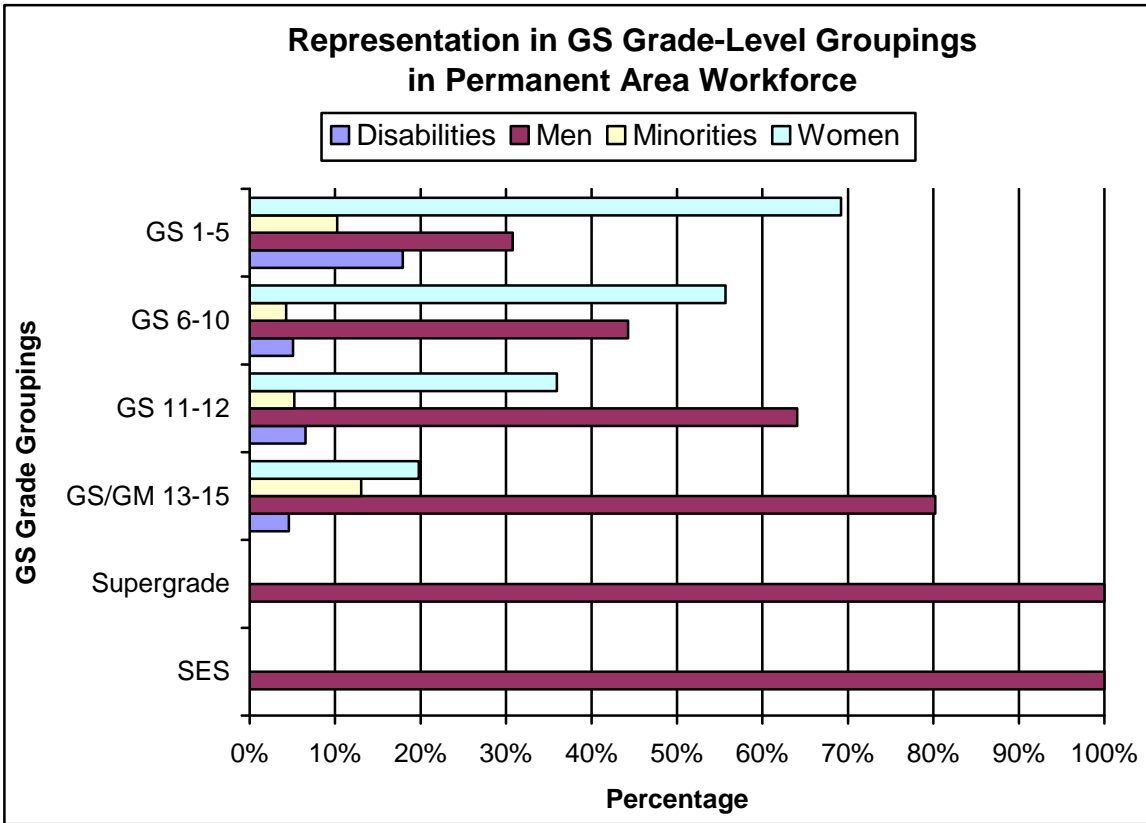
Permanent Area Workforce by Occupational Category

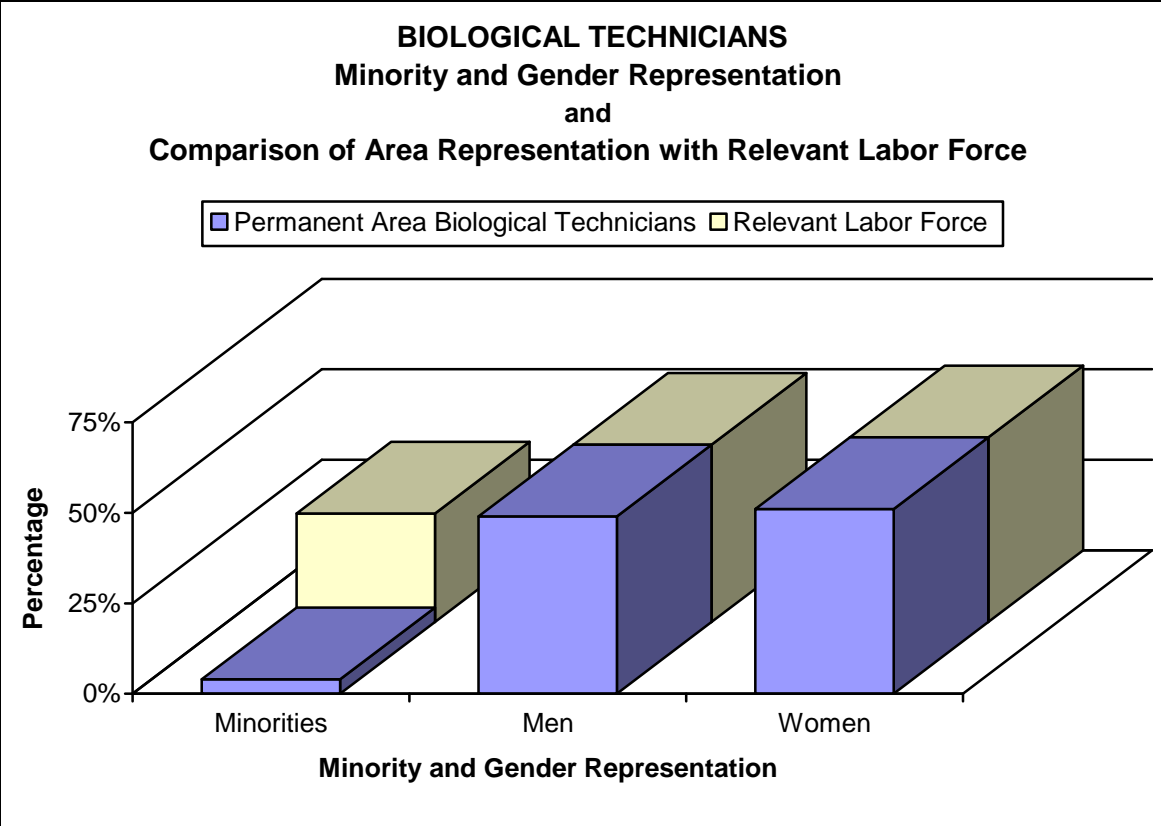
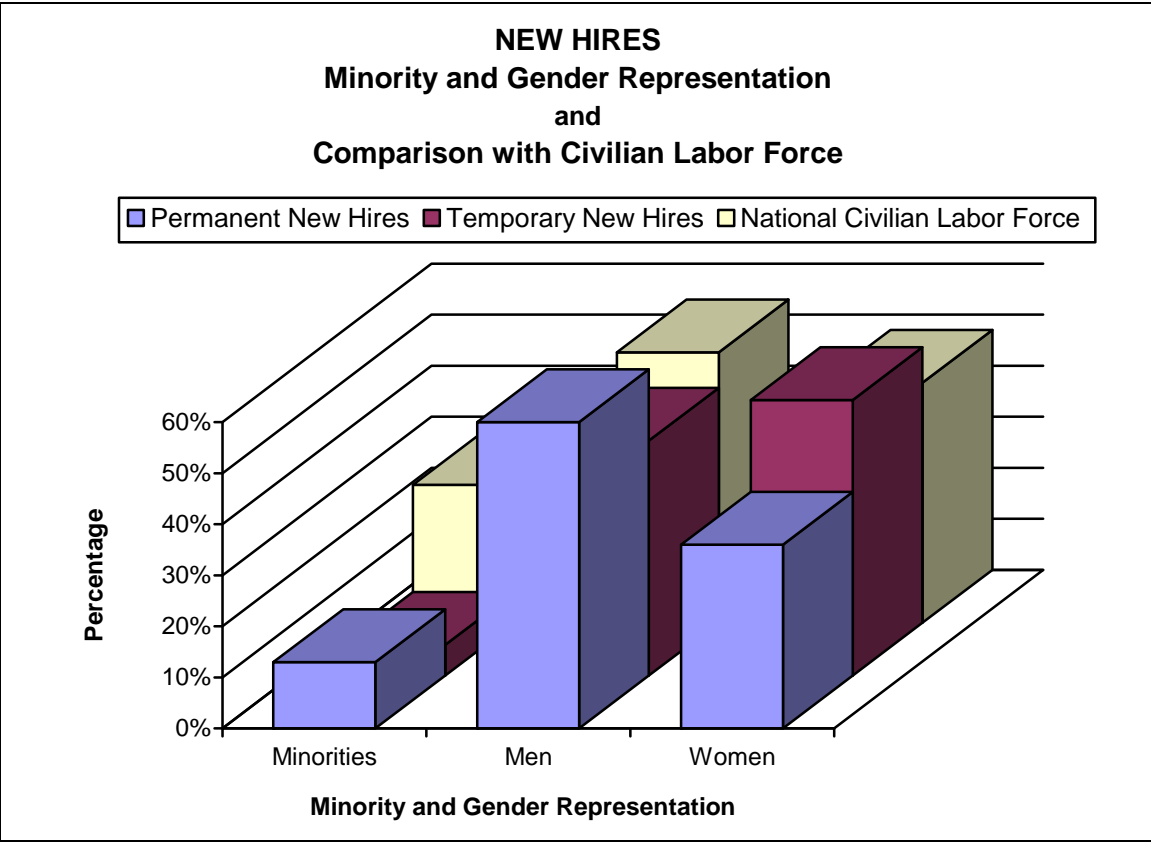


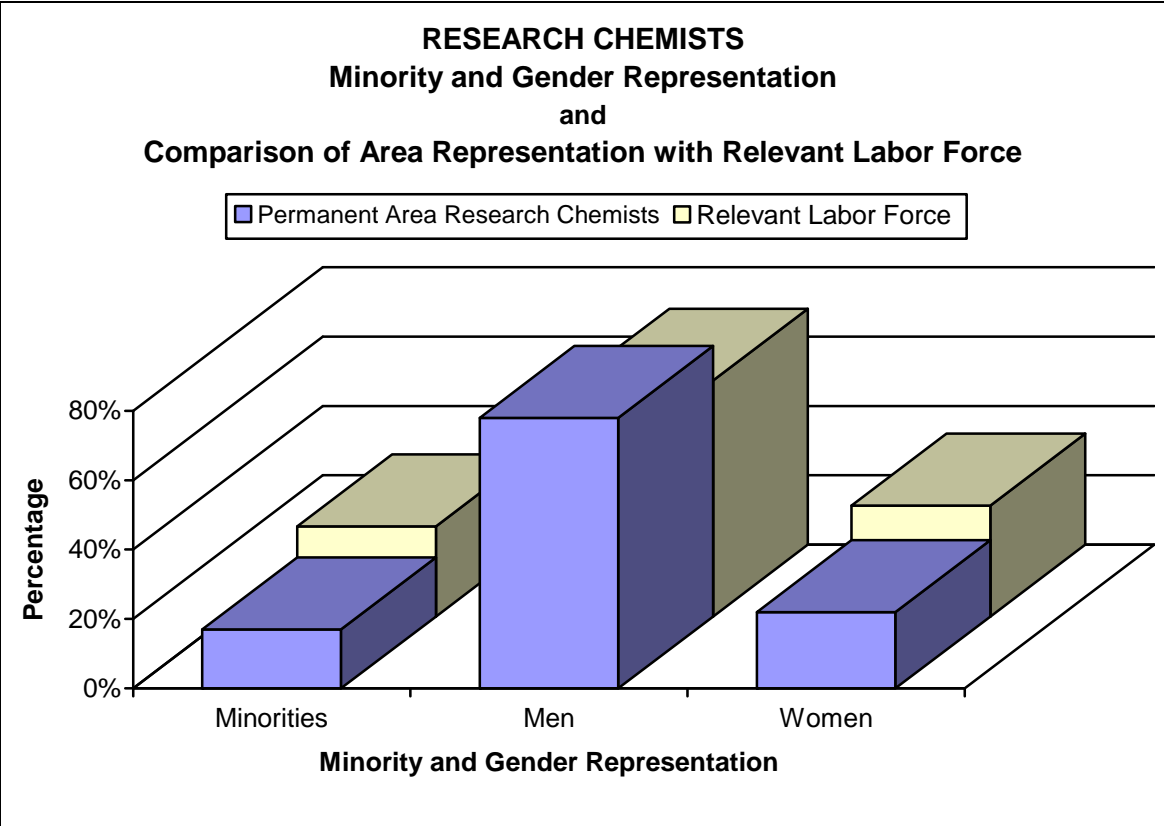
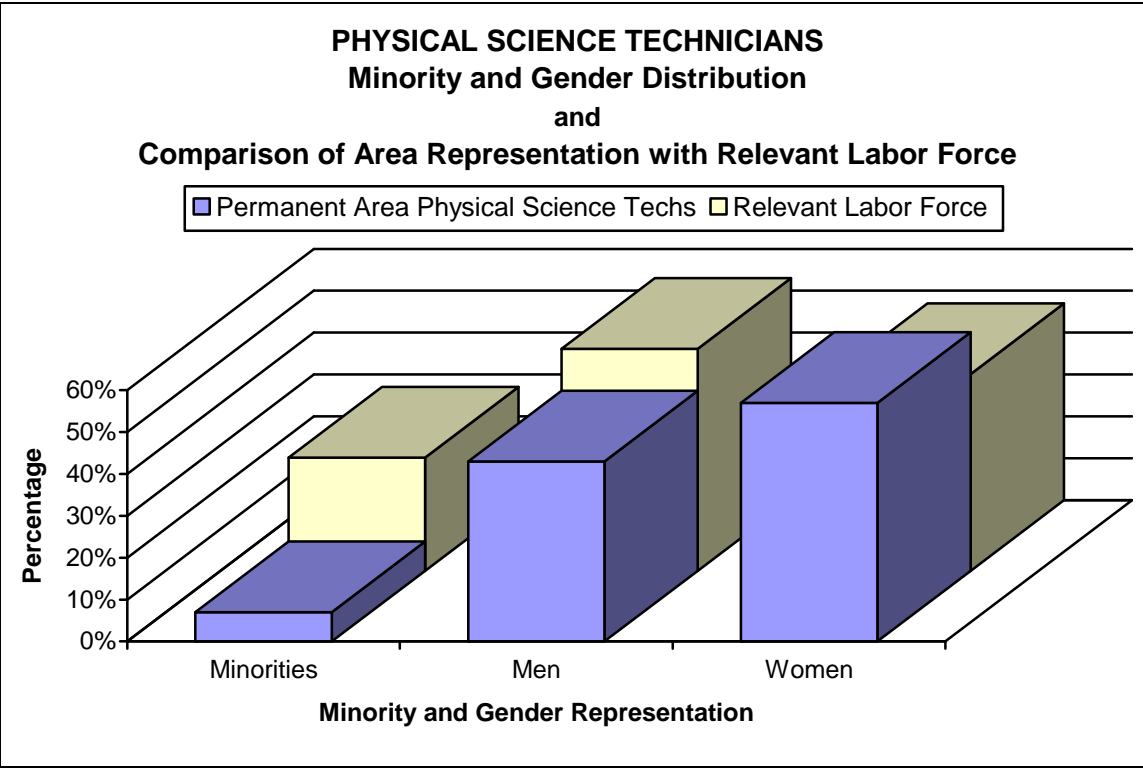

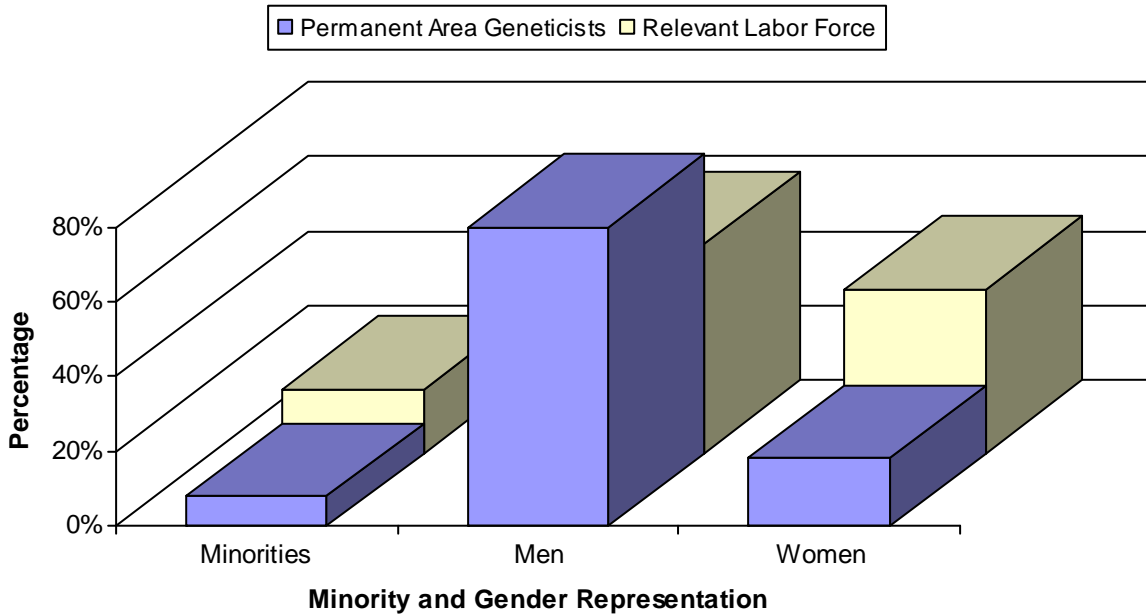
