Usse this form to report the age, sex, and race of all persons under 18 years of age taken into custody during the month for committing an offense of the indicated types within the local jurisdiction. (Include those released without having been formally charged.) For purposes of Uniform Crime Reporting, a juvenile should be counted as "Arrested" when the circumstances are such that if he or she were an adult, an arrest would be tallied. Police "contacts" with juveniles where no offense has been committed should not be scored as arrests. Instances where a juvenile is taken into custody for his own protection, such as "neglect," and no crime committed, should not be listed as arrests. Enter on the front of this form your disposition of all juveniles arrested.
- 2. Arrests of persons 18 years of age and over are tallied on the adult Age, Sex, and Race reporting form.
