
Dear Interested Party:

I am writing in regard to the Ghost Town Fuel Hazard Reduction project. The Bureau of Land Management is proposing to complete the remaining 304 acre hazardous fuel reduction treatment around Garnet and Coloma Ghost Towns. The initial test project was started in 2004 and was used to determine the effectiveness of various fuel reduction techniques around historic structures and features.
