



ERIC Unveils New Look, Help, and Tutorials

ERIC announces the release of a new Web site structure and design at www.eric.ed.gov. The new ERIC Web site features several enhancements that will make the experience of using the site easier and faster for individual researchers, along with improvements to aid librarians in supporting ERIC users. These enhancements include improved navigation, expanded help and training, an information area for librarians, and a lighter visual design:

- Restructured navigation makes site usage more intuitive to speed information discovery.
- ERIC's Help feature has been expanded to include brief tutorials, a glossary, and a searchable index. Help has been fully integrated into the ERIC Web site through the use of context-sensitive Help features such as tool tips and How do I links.
- A new area for librarians provides access to flyers, brochures, lists of ERIC microfiche, and other relevant information, including ways to provide feedback about ERIC.
- Site pages load faster with a lighter visual design, and new graphics refresh the site while retaining ERIC's look and feel.

The features and functionality of ERIC search and My ERIC have not been changed in the current release.

ERIC has modified the site in response to user feedback identified through emails, user research, and usability testing. The changes and enhancements reflect our commitment to continuous improvement.

New Journals Boost ERIC Collection

Coverage

ERIC recently signed agreements with journal publishers to add more than 130 education-focused journals to the ERIC Collection. As of June 30, 2008, ERIC has added more than 3,600 new records from these journals. The new journals are in addition to 600 titles already being indexed, and are part of a plan to expand journal coverage even further. New journals are indexed from 2004 forward, except for titles indexed prior to ERIC's 2004 transition to an all-electronic service. ERIC is acquiring 2002-2003 electronic back issues of these previously indexed titles to prevent gaps in journal coverage.

The online list of Journals Indexed in ERIC will be updated later this year, as part of an upgrade to this area of the Web site.

ERIC is also expanding the collection of nonjournal literature. Recent agreements include materials from:

- California Childcare Health Program (University of California San Francisco, School of Nursing)
- Center of Mental Health in Schools (UCLA)
- eEducation Group (Texas A&M University)
- Institute on Community Integration (University of Minnesota)
- National Foundation for Educational Research (Berkshire, UK)

ERIC acknowledges the collaborative efforts of the library community, ERIC Content Experts, and the Department of Education in their contributions to ERIC's robust yet systematic collection development program. The ERIC user community is also invited to submit recommendations for education-related materials to be considered for inclusion in the ERIC Collection.
