Poster Instructions

Contents

The P3 Poster should contain **summaries** of all of the following six major elements of the P3 project report. P3 teams must provide a comprehensive overview of their research objectives and results, as well as publications and presentations, in language that would be understood by the educated public. P3 teams should describe conclusions and implications for further research, development, or implementation. P3 teams are **strongly encouraged to present the information with photographs, tables, graphs, and charts** where appropriate and to provide web site links to their publications or related research efforts.

- Relationship to people, prosperity and the planet
- · Relevancy and significance to developing or developed world
- Implementation of the P3 team project as an educational tool
- 2. Purpose, Objectives, Scope
- 3. Data, Findings, Outputs/Outcomes
 - Streamlined life cycle costing and analysis, if appropriate
 - Quantifiable and qualitative benefits to people, prosperity and the planet
- 4. Discussion, Conclusions, Recommendations
- 5. Proposed P3 Phase II Project Description
- 6. References

Format

P3 teams should use the PowerPoint templates that have been provided. Two templates are provided: The main poster template (36"x56") and the supplemental poster template (36"x30"). These two posters must be displayed and are the only items that are permitted to be displayed on the provided poster board (8'x8' with 4'x8' of useable space). An 8' table will be placed in front of the poster board for supplemental materials. Space outside of the tent will be provided for large displays. Those teams that wish to display outside of the tent need to coordinate with Jennifer Legge at Jennifer.Larkin.Legge@saic.com regarding their plans for exhibiting outside of the tent.

A number will be assigned to your team in late March. This number should be placed in the upper left corner of the main (landscape) poster and on the final report. As noted on the template, we recommend that the following fonts be used:

Headings: Arial Black 72 point (color black)

Body Text: Arial 36 to 60 point depending on amount (color black).

Photo captions, text in charts and graphs: Arial no smaller than 24 point (color black unless different colors are necessary for the graphic).

The posters should be printed in color in the following dimensions:

- Main poster template [36" (h) x56" (w)]
- Supplemental poster template [36" (h) x30" (w)].
