Re: Revised Information Quality Bulletin for Peer Review

Request for Extension of Comment Period

Dear Dr. Schwab:

The undersigned organizations join in requesting a 120-day interagency review process on the draft Revised Bulletin on Peer Review.

Federal agencies have extensive experience with scientific information, peer review and the regulatory process. It is essential that OMB consider these agencies' opinions during the development of a government-wide peer review policy. The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) recognized the importance of agencies' feedback during the review of the original draft Peer Review Bulletin and undertook a separate comment process specifically for federal agencies. OMB encouraged agencies to provide feedback on "the expected benefits and burdens of this proposed Bulletin."

Currently, the revised proposal does not have a process to elicit feedback from these important agencies. Given the proposal's substantial revision, it is vital that OMB reengage the agencies to determine the impacts of the revised proposal on the regulatory process. This bulletin will significantly affect the operations of agencies and it is important to ensure that their concerns and questions are adequately addressed during this process.
