PROPOSED RULES AND REQUESTS FOR COMMENT

The Commission issued a release soliciting comment on proposed Rules 2a19-2 and 2a3-1 under the Investment Company Act of 1940 (Act). Proposed Rule 2a19-2 would conditionally exempt certain general partners serving as directors of management investment companies and business development companies from the definition of "interested person" under the Act. Rule 2a3-1 would exempt certain limited partners from the definition of "affiliated person" under the Act.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS WHITE SANCTIONED

Chief Administrative Law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision suspending Thomas F. White of San Francisco, California from acting in a supervisory capacity with any broker or dealer for a period of one year.

Judge Blair found that White as President, Chief Executive Officer, and Sales Manager of White & Co., a registered broker-dealer, failed reasonably to supervise Steven M. Roberta, a White & Co. salesman subject to White's supervision, with a view to preventing violations of antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and Securities Exchange Act of 1934. These violations were committed by Roberta in 1989 in connection with the offer and sale of securities of a fictitious company. (Initial Decision Rel. 29)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-30) to Amend Part III Section 13(f) of the NASD's Code of Arbitration Procedure. The proposal would codify the NASD's existing policy of appointing a public arbitrator as the single arbitrator in small claims cases involving public customers. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 3. (Rel. 34-30960)

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-16) to enhance operation of SelectNet service by adding Consolidated Quotation Service securities to those eligible for trading through SelectNet. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 3. (Rel. 34-30961)

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

The following list is of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column - 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
