COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION ISSUES NEW REFERENCE BOOK

The Commission today issued a new reference book, Welcome to the SEC's Public Reference Room -- Guide to Filings made with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission. The guide lists all filings made with the Commission, explains procedures for obtaining them and provides other pertinent data for obtaining copies of the documents required to be filed with the Commission and made public, for the benefit of investors.

Prepared by Ernest Lewis, a Commission employee (on his own time), the booklet is available free of charge from the Public Reference Room. (Press Release 85-44)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 16 to request a hearing on a proposal by Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to finance pollution control facilities at AP&L's Arkansas Nuclear One Generating Station in Pope County, Arkansas (County). AP&L will enter into one or more installment sale agreements (Agreement) with the County which will contemplate the issuance by the County of one or more series of its pollution control revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$150 million. AP&L may enter into a reimbursement agreement with a bank by a letter of credit or acquire commercial bond insurance or issue first mortgage bonds to secure its obligations under the Agreement. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-11) to amend Schedule D of its By-Laws. The proposal provides that data pertaining to the value of mutual funds and yields of money market funds will be collected and disseminated through the NASD Automated Quotation System's central computers under the Mutual Fund Quotation Program. (Rel. 34-22264)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Options Clearing Corporation filed the following proposed rule changes: (SR-OCC-85-11) to amend its By-Laws and Rules to accommodate European style foreign currency options. The proposal also expands the availability of OCC's alternative foreign currency option exercise settlement procedures. (Rel. 34-22267); and (SR-OCC-85-12) which would expressly authorize its Chairman to designate another OCC officer to act on the Chairman's behalf at OCC Securities Committee meetings. (Rel. 34-22268)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

SHELL OIL COMPANY

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Shell Oil Company that the trusteeship of Irving Trust Company (the Bank) under existing indentures and a new indenture is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under the new indenture.
