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## CORPORATE REORGANIZATION RELEASES

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### EVANS PRODUCTS COMPANY

The Commission filed a brief on November 27 in the bankruptcy appeal of Evans Products Company to the District Court urging that the Bankruptcy Code permits regular reimbursement of actual, necessary expenses of official committees of creditors or equity security holders on the same standard applicable to other official participants in the case: that the activities which led to the incurring of the expenses were in furtherance of the statutory duties of official committees under the Bankruptcy Code. The official equity committee's application to establish a procedure for the reimbursement of its expenses - a routinely authorized procedure for official committees in Chapter 11 - was denied by the bankruptcy court on the basis that the Bankruptcy Code did not specifically provide for such reimbursement. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### PUTNAM HIGH INCOME GOVERNMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 10, 1986 to request a hearing on an application filed by Putnam High Income Government Trust and Putnam Option Income Trust II (Applicants), requesting an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 19(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 19b-1. 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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-85-34) to amend Sections 103 and 104 of the Amex Company Guide to permit listing of convertible preferred stock and convertible debt, which grants the issuer discretion temporarily to reduce the conversion price of the preferred stock or debt, so long as the reduced price is in effect for at least ten business days. The rule change also amends Section 104 to permit listing of convertible debt securities of non-Amex listed issuers which are subject to last sale reporting. (Rel. 34-22714); and The Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-85-34) to institute revisions in its Specialist Evaluation Pilot Program. These changes relate to the guidelines used for specialist evaluation, including National Market System Quote Performance, Specialist Evaluation Questionnaire and SCOREX Limit Order Acceptance. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 16.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
