CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

STEPHEN W. MURPHY FOUND GUILTY OF CRIMINAL CONTEMPT

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on August 17 the Honorable Cynthia Holcomb Hall of the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California found Stephen W. Murphy guilty of criminal contempt of a prior injunction entered against him. Murphy had been permanently enjoined from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws [SEC v. Intertie, Inc., et al., see LR-8603, November 21, 1978].

On May 11, 1983, the Commission filed an application for an Order to Show Cause alleging that Murphy violated the prior injunction in the offer and sale of \$483,000 of limited partnership interests to 23 investors from November 1979 through February 1980. The Commission's application alleged that the documents used to offer and sell the limited partnership interests contained false and misleading statements and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the use of investors' funds and the commingling of investors' funds with the funds of other business entities controlled by Murphy. The application further alleged that he misappropriated to his own use and benefit a substantial portion of the proceeds raised from investors. (SEC v. Stephen W. Murphy, USDC CD CA, Action No. 75-2775-CHH). (LR-10100)

TAYLOR PLEADS GUILTY TO FRAUD

The U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of Utah, the Denver Regional and the Salt Lake Branch Offices announced that Veldon D. Taylor, formerly of Provo, Utah and presently of Broken Bow, Nebraska, pled guilty to three felony counts of securities fraud, mail fraud, and wire fraud in the offer and sale of promissory notes and money management agreements of T & D Management Company. The Information filed charged Taylor with operating a scheme to defraud investors by soliciting and obtaining money which he pooled and invested in commodity contracts, primarily through T & D Management Co., a partnership. Taylor was charged with, among other things, falsely representing to investors his past profits from investing in commodities and the use of proceeds received from investors. (U.S. v. Veldon D. Taylor, USDC, UT, CR-83-93-W). (LR-10101)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEICO MUNICIPAL SECURITIES SERIES TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 on an application of Washington National Insurance Company, Separate Account I of Washington National Insurance Company and Washington National Equity Company exempting Separate Account I from the provisions of Section 2(a)(41) of the Act and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 to permit the Money Market Sub-Account of Separate Account I to use the amortized cost method of valuing its portfolio securities.
