DECISION IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

FORMER McDONNELL EMPLOYEE SUSPENDED. The Commission has issued an order suspending Edward S. Pencarski, formerly a salesman in the Washington, D. C. office of McDonnell & Co., from association with a broker-dealer for twelve months. (McDonnell's broker-dealer registration was revoked in 1970.) According to the decision, between September 1967 and June 1968 Pencarski violated antifraud provisions of the securities acts in that, among other things, he induced customers to engage in excessive trading and in speculative investment practices not suitable to their investment objectives and financial circumstances, established margin accounts without customers' authorization and effected unauthorized transactions in customers' accounts.

The Commission's order was issued pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Pencarski, without admitting or denying the allegations in the order for proceedings, consented to the findings and suspension. (Rel. 34-9271)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

SEC ORDER CITES SUTZ & ROSS. The SEC has ordered administrative proceedings against Sutz & Ross, Inc., North Valley Stream, N. Y., Barry Sutz and Andrew Bryan Ross based upon allegations of the bookkeeping, financial reporting, filing, net capital and anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The order alleges that Sutz and Ross, Inc., aided and abetted by Sutz and Ross, failed to file an accurate broker dealer registration statement and amendments thereto with the Commission, failed to make and keep current certain of its books and records, failed to file reports of financial condition, and conducted business during times when the firm did not maintain minimum net capital and did not maintain adequate capital in relation to its indebtedness, as required by the Rules under the Exchange Act. In addition, the order alleges that Sutz and Ross, Inc., aided and abetted by Sutz and Ross engaged in fraudulent conduct and made false statements and omissions in that Registrant, Sutz and Ross failed to deliver fully paid securities and money to customers, converted customers money to their own use, and conducted a securities business while insolvent.

A hearing will be held to take evidence on the staff allegations and to afford the respondents an opportunity to offer any defenses thereto, and to determine if the allegations are true and, if so, whether any remedial action should be ordered by the Commission.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

FINANCIAL EQUITIES, OTHERS ENJOINED. The SEC San Francisco Regional Office announced that on July 29 the Federal court in Los Angeles permanently enjoined Financial Equities, Ltd., a Los Angeles based broker-dealer formerly named Redmond, Luxenberg & Associates, and Roy S. Redmond and Daniel H. Luxenberg, its principals, from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws in connection with the sale of stock of Barr Financial, Ltd. Wensel J. Mattauch, a Los Angeles accountant, was enjoined from violations of the antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws. The defendants consented to the Court order without admitting or denying the allegations. Upon his failure to appear, the court preliminarily enjoined Duane L. Hanson from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws. The hearing on the Commission's motion to preliminarily enjoin the remaining defendants, Barr Financial, Ltd., Financial Communications, Inc., Chess Wilburn Barr, III, Louis C. Schiess and Ronald W. Branham, was continued to August 30, 1971 at 10:00 a.m. (LR-5121)

LOWENTHAL, HALE, JAFFE, INC. ENJOINED. The SEC Washington Regional Office announced that on August 2 the U. S. District court in Philadelphia permanently enjoined Lowenthal, Hale, Jaffe, Inc., a Philadelphia broker-dealer, Eugene Jaffe, Glenside, Pa., president, and Albert Halebogou, Oreland, Pa., an employee, from further violations of the net capital, recordkeeping and related provisions of the Federal securities laws. The defendants consented to the Court order without admitting or denying the allegations. (LR-5122)

FINANCIAL SECURITY CORP. ENJOINED. The SEC San Francisco Regional Office and the Los Angeles Branch Office announced August 3 that the Federal court in California had permanently enjoined Financial Security Corporation, Garden Grove, Calif. broker-dealer, from further violations of the anti-fraud and net capital provisions of the Federal securities laws. Sheldon Jaffe, a Los Angeles attorney, was named temporary receiver until such time as the Securities Investor Protection Corporation determines whether or not to make application to the Court for appointment of a Trustee. RUSCO INDUSTRIES, CATAIN ENJOINED. The SEC New York Regional Office announced August 4 that the Federal court in New York had permanently enjoined Rusco Industries, Inc., Los Angeles, and Jack Catain, Jr., board chairman, president and chief executive officer, from violations of the antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws. Rusco and Catain consented to the Court order without admitting or denying the allegations. The Court order also declared the proxies obtained by Rusco management by means of a definitive proxy statement dated May 29, 1971, null and void and directs Rusco to resolicit proxies of shareholders for the election of directors. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASE

AMWAY MUTUAL FUND. The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act permitting Amway Mutual Fund, Inc., Ada, Mich. mutual fund, to acquire from Amway Corporation portfolio securities in consideration for shares of Amway Fund common stock. (Release IC-6664)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INDIANA & MICHIGAN ELECTRIC CO. The SEC has issued a notice under the Holding Company Act giving interested persons until August 20 to request a hearing upon an application of Indiana & Michigan Electric Company (I&M), Fort Wayne, Ind. subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc.) and its newly-organized Bridgman, Mich. subsidiary, Indiana & Michigan Power Company (I&M Power), with respect to a financing program for I&M Power. I&M Power was organized to own and operate the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Generating Plant, which I&M is presently constructing at Bridgman, Mich. It is proposed that I&M Power issue and sell from time to time up to \$200 million of notes to banks to mature in 1977, that I&M make up to \$130 million of capital contributions to I&M, and that I&M Power will make available to I&M all of the power available at the Donald C. Cook Plant and I&M will pay I&M Power amounts sufficient for I&M Power to pay operating and certain other expenses. (Release 35-17214)

PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act authorizing Pennsylvania Electric Company, Johnstown, Pa. subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to issue and sell \$20 million of debentures, due 1996, at competitive bidding. Net proceeds will be used for the payment of \$20 million of short-term bank loans (estimated to aggregate \$34 million at the time of the debenture sale). Construction expenditures are estimated at \$91,100,000 for 1971. (Release 35-17219)

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

1971 GREAT BASINS EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, (the partnership), 1011 Gateway West, Century City, Los Angeles, Calif. 90067, filed a registration on August 4 seeking registration of \$1,000,000 of partnership interests, to be offered for public sale at \$5,000 per unit. The partnership will engage primarily in exploration, development and production of oil and gas. Great Basins Petroleum Co. is the general partner. (File 2-41382)

CLINTON OIL COMPANY 1971 OIL AND GAS PROGRAM, (the Partnership), 1 East First St., First National Bank Bldg., Reno, Nev. 89501, filed a registration statement on August 4 seeking registration of \$25 million of limited partnership interest to be offered for public sale in \$5,000 units. Clinton Oil Company is the general partner. (File 2-41385)

TRANSAMERICA FINANCIAL CORPORATION, 1150 South Olive St., Los Angeles, Calif. 90015, filed a registration statement on August 4 seeking registration of \$50 million of sinking fund debentures, due 1991, to be offered for public sale through underwriters headed by Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Inc., 70 Pine St., and Salomon Brothers, 60 Wall St., both of New York. The company is principally engaged in the consumer and commercial financing business and the title insurance business. Net proceeds of its stock sale will be applied to the reduction of short-term debt incurred to provide funds for current transactions in the ordinary course of business. (File 2-41384)

CONDEC CORPORATION, 1700 Boston Post Road, Old Greenwich, Conn. 06870, filed a registration statement on August 4 seeking registration of \$10 million of convertible subordinated debentures, to be offered for public sale through underwriters headed by Bear, Stearns & Co., One Wall St., New York 10005. The company is engaged in the manufacture of industrial and residential valves, equipment sold primarily to the Government and production machinery for plastics and tire and rubber industries. Net proceeds of its debenture sale will be used to retire short-term bank indebtedness incurred in connection with the acquisitions of all the stock of NRM Corporation from AMK Corporation. GILCO INVESTMENT TO SELL STOCK. Gilco Investment Corp., 1200 Merchants Bank Bldg., Indianapolis, Ind. 46204, filed a registration statement on August 4 seeking registration of 400,000 shares of Class A stock, to be offered for public sale in units of ten shares at \$100 per unit. No underwriting is involved. Organized in July, the company proposes to act as a holding company for Golden Investors Life Insurance Company, which will be formed to engage in the life insurance business. Of the net proceeds of Gilco's stock sale, at least \$1,396,500 will be invested in Golden Investors Life and the balance for general corporate purposes. (File 2-41387)

BELDEN & BLAKE AND COMPANY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP NO. 47 (File 2-41388) and LIMITED PARTNERSHIP NO. 46 (File 2-41389), 702 Tuscarawas St., West Canton, Ohio 44702, filed two registration statements on August 4 each seeking registration of \$3 million of partnership units, to be offered for public sale at \$3,000 per unit. The Partnerships are to be formed to engage in oil and gas drilling and exploration activities in Ohio. Henry S. Belden III and Glenn A. Blake are the general partners. MISCELLANEOUS

DELISTING GRANTED. The SEC has issued an order under the Securities Exchange Act granting an application of the New York Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the common stock of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, effective at the opening of business on August 5, 1971. Information believed by the Exchange to be reliable indicates that only about 380,000 shares were publicly held at June 16, 1971, as a result of an exchange offer by Western Pacific Industries, which now owns some 81% of the stock.
