COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

TRADING IN ECOLOGICAL SCIENCE SUSPENDED. The SEC has ordered the temporary suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Ecological Science Corporation, 20215 N. W. Second Avenue, Miami, Fla. commencing August 17 and terminating August 26, 1971. The Commission action was taken on the basis of facts coming to its attention which indicates that information presently public concerning Ecological and its current financial condition may be incomplete. Therefore pending receipt of more complete information the Commission deems it in the public interest that exchange and over-the-counter trading in the stock of Ecological be suspended.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INVESTMENT/INDICATORS FUND. The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act on application of Investment/Indicators Fund, San Francisco, permitting applicant to continue to suspend the right of redemption of its outstanding redeemable securities and continue to suspend payment for shares already submitted for redemption and on which payment has not been made prior to this date, until fifteen days after applicant mails to its shareholders a statement indicating its intention to resume redemptions and setting forth certain additional information, but providing that such suspension of redemption and payment shall in no event continue beyond the end of the twentieth day following August 13, 1971, the date of the SEC's order. BANKERS LIFE SEPARATE ACCOUNT. The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act exempting Bankers Life Company Separate Account B, a unit investment trust, Bankers Life Company, a mutual life insurance company, and BLC Equity Services Corp., all of Des Moines, from certain provisions of the Act so as to permit, among other things, an exchange of amounts accumulated under certain contracts issued by Bankers Life to group variable annuity contracts participating in Account B without sales charge. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act authorizing the General Public Utilites Corporation, New York holding company, to increase the amount of cash capital contributions it may make to two subsidiaries from time to time up to December 31, 1971, as follows: New Jersey Power & Light Co. - from \$4.9 million to \$10.5 million and Metropolitan Edison Company - from \$34.8 million to \$52.1 million. PHILADELPHIA NATIONAL & FOUR OTHER BANKS. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act declaring that the following banks will not be "electric ucility companies" within the meaning of the Act as a result of certain transactions respecting the purchase, sale and leasing of electric generating equipment: The Philadelphia National Bank, The Commonwealth National Bank, The First National Bank of Saint Paul, South Jersey National Bank and Union Trust Company of Maryland. GULF POWER COMPANY. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act authorizing Gulf Power Company, Pensacola subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell 50,600 shares of cumulative preferred stock (\$100 par), to be offered for public sale at competitive bidding. Net proceeds of its stock sale, together with funds from internal sources will be used to refund \$5,060,000 of first mortgage bonds, 3-1/8% which mature on September 1, 1971. (Release 35-17235)

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

FLORIDA GAS COMPANY, 1560 Orange Ave., Winter Park, Fla. 32789, filed a registration statement on August 13 seeking registration of \$25 million of convertible subordinated debentures, due 1991, to be offered for public sale through underwriters headed by Blyth & Co., Inc., 14 Wall St., New York 10005. The company will use some \$15 million of the net proceeds to retire short-term borrowings incurred in connection with the expansion of its distribution systems and its investment in allied diversification activities and the balance for general corporate purposes, primarily oil and gas exploration and land development. THE CONNECTICUT WATER COMPANY, West Main St., Clinton, Conn. 06413, filed a registration statement on August 13 seeking registration of 70,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale (*at \$17.50 per share maximum) through underwriters headed by Putnam, Coffin, Doolittle, Newburger, Division of Advest Co., 6 Central Row, Hartford, Conn. 06103. Net proceeds of its stock sale will be used to reduce short-term bank loans incurred to finance the company's construction program. Construction expenditures are estimated at \$1.4 million for 1971. (File 2-41455)

VIRGINIA ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY, 700 East Franklin St., Richmond, Va. 23261, filed two registration statements anAugust 13 seeking registration of (a) \$50 million of first and refunding mortgage bonds, Series BB, due 2001, to be offered for public sale at competitive bidding (File 2-41464) and (b) 4,000,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale (*at \$23 per share maximum) through underwriters headed by Merrill Lynch, Pierca, Fenner & Smith, Inc., 70 Pine St., New York 10005 (File 2-41465). Net proceeds of its financing will be used for construction expenditures and for the retirement of short-term indebtedness incurred for that purpose. Construction expenditures are estimated at \$379.6 million for 1971. (File 2-41464 and File 2-41465)

MISCELLANEOUS

<u>DELISTING GRANTED</u>. The SEC has issued an order under the Securities Exchange Act granting an application of the Midwest Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the 3% first mortgage bonds, due 1980 and the 3-3/4% first mortgage bonds, due 1978, of Interstate Power Company, effective at the opening of business on August 16, 1971, due to inactive trading on the Exchange. Both series of bonds remain listed and registered on the New York Stock Exchange (34-9299)

CORRECTION RE BELDEN & BLAKE. Belden & Blake and Company Limited Partnership No. 47 (File 2-41388) and Limited Partnership No. 46 (File 2-41389), 702 Tuscarawas St., West, Canton, Chio 44702, filed two registration statements with the SEC on August 4, each seeking registration of \$600,000 of partnership units, to be offered for public sale at \$3,000 per unit (not each seeking registration of \$3 million of partnership units, as reported in the News Digest of August 9).
