CHAIRMAN GARRETT REVIEWS THE SEC'S CONCERN WITH BANK TRUST ACTIVITIES

"Today it seems less and less appropriate to allocate regulatory responsibility according to corporate entity," Chairman Ray Garrett, Jr., told a group of bankers at their 55th National Trust Conference in San Francisco on February 4th. The significant expansion of bank investment services, he said, has involved banks in a world of equity securities, with a concomitant involvement of banks with the federal securities laws. "If a bank operates and distributes shares of something that is indistinguishable from a mutual fund for all purposes, except legal form, should it not be subject to the same regulation as the mutual fund itself?" he asked.

Mr. Garrett cited the Commission's present concern and responsibility to preserve and foster the fairness and efficiency of the securities markets. "Today," he said, "the investment policies followed by bank trust departments, the investment services they offer, and the spate of new investor services being offered and proposed by banks generally, have come under closer scrutiny because of their potential impact upon the fairness and efficiency of our capital markets."

In conclusion, Mr. Garrett pointed out "If the banking industry wishes to expand its operations into more traditional securities activities, it should be willing to assist the Congress, the Commission and the banking authorities in a re-examination of the principles underlying the present regulatory framework, in an environment free of distracting jealousies and suspicions." He assured that the Commission is preparing to undertake such an effort and looks forward to the much-needed cooperation of the industry.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEUWIRTH FUND. An order has been issued on an application of Neuwirth Fund, Inc. and Neuwirth Century Fund, Inc. both open-end investment companies (Funds), and Clark, Dodge & Co. Incorporated (Clark, Dodge), an investment adviser. The order permits the Funds, after approval by their respective shareholders to make retroactive payments to Clark, Dodge of advisory fees, less previously reimbursed costs and expenses of Clark, Dodge, from November 1, 1973, to January 24, 1974, the date scheduled for special meetings of shareholders of the Fund (or any adjournment thereof) at which the payments of such fees shall be submitted to shareholders for approval. COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

ARTHUR J. GROESBECK, III, OTHERS ENJOINED. The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on January 21 the Federal court in Los Angeles permanently enjoined Arthur J. Groesbeck, III, A. J. Groesbeck Financial Advisors, Inc., Griffin Properties Corporation, Compumangement Company, and Griffin Securities Corporation, all of Los Angeles, from violations of the registration, antifraud and certain reporting provisions of the securities laws in the alleged distribution of unregistered and fraudulent limited partnership interests in real estate syndications. The defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations consented to a court order enjoining them from future violations.

Harry L. Nelson was appointed by the Court as the conservator for 35 of the limited partnerships in which interests have been offered and sold by the defendants. (LR-6230)

TREASURE SALVORS, INC., OTHERS ENJOINED. Atlanta Regional Office announced that the U. S. District Court in Miami, Florida on January 28 permanently enjoined Treasure Salvors, Inc., Armada Research, Inc. and Melvin A. Fisher, all of Key West, Florida, from violating the registration provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of profit-sharing agreements issued by Salvors and Armada, as well as offers and sales of Salvors' stock. The defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the court order. (LR-6231)

CHARLES T. DOLAN CONVICTED. The Denver Regional Office announced on January 25 that Charles T. Dolan of Englewood, Colorado was convicted by a Federal Grand Jury in Denver on three counts of securities fraud and one count of mail fraud in the offer and sale to investors of common stock of United States Investment Corporation between January 9, 1968 and December 31, 1969 in a scheme to defraud. No date has been set for sentencing. (LR-6232)

BRYAN H. O'HARA, OTHERS, ENJOINED. The Washington Regional Office announced that on January 29 the U. S. District Court for the District of Columbia permanently enjoined by consent Bryan H. O'Hara, Glen Head, New York, and Samuel B. Kogen and Samuel B. Kogen Associates Ltd., both from Elkins Park, Pennsylvania from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. O'Hara, Kogen and Associates had been engaged in the offer and sale of investments in Scotch whiskey in the Eastern United States. The defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (LR-6234)
