CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

GREATER HERITAGE CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on June 19 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Greater Heritage Corporation of Lincolnwood, Illinois. The Final Judgment restrains and enjoins Heritage from failing to file timely periodic reports and orders Heritage to file its delinquent Form 10-Q Quarterly Report for its fiscal quarter ended March 31, 1984, within ten days after the entry of the Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction. The May 11 complaint alleges that Heritage, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file and file timely with the Commission certain annual and quarterly reports required to have been filed. Heritage, consenting to the Court's judgment, admitted that it filed reports in an untimely manner on 14 separate occasions and failed to file Notification of Late Filing on ten separate occasions. (SEC v. Greater Heritage Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 84-1474, 1984). (LR-10423)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF ENTERED AGAINST DAVID A. CRABTREE

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on June 5 Judge Thomas G. Hull, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee, Northern Division, issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against David A. Crabtree, a former director of the Southern Industrial Banking Corporation of Knoxville, Tennessee. Crabtree consented to the Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint. The Permanent Injunction restrains Crabtree from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of investment certificates of Southern Industrial or any other securities.

In its January 26, 1984 complaint, the Commission alleged that Crabtree and others made misrepresentations of material facts, including but not limited to, the financial condition of Southern Industrial and the extent of transactions or loans between the bank, its officers, directors, shareholders or their affiliates.

The remaining defendants, Cecil H. Butcher, Jr., James E. Steiner, and David G. Payne continue to litigate this matter. (SEC v. Cecil H. Butcher, Jr., et al., ED TN, Northern Division, Civil Action No. 3-84-83). (LR-10424)

FIRST INTEREST SECURITIES CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Denver Regional Office announced that on June 7 Judge John Moore, U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado, entered an order permanently enjoining First Interwest Securities Corporation, a Denver, Colorado broker-dealer, from future violations of the net capital provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 15c3-1. First Interwest consented to the order without admitting or denying the allegations. Simultaneously with the filing of the Commission's June 7 complaint, the Securities Investor Protection Corporation filed, and First Interwest consented to, an application for the issuance of a protective decree and appointment of a trustee under the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970. Judge Moore appointed Glen E. Keller of Davis, Graham & Stubbs trustee for the liquidation of the business of First Interwest. (SEC v. First Interwest Securities Corporation, USDC CO, Civil Action No. 84-JM-1179). (LR-10425)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HUTTON INVESTMENT SERIES INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Hutton Investment Series Inc. (Applicant), an open-end, diversified, management investment company, amending a previous order -- which had exempted Applicant from the provisions of Sections

2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 2(a)(41), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 -- so as to permit Applicant to provide for an additional waiver of its contingent deferred sales charges respecting periodic redemptions of its shares under the systematic withdrawal plan that it proposes to offer shareholders having accounts of \$10,000 or more. GREAT-WEST LIFE AND ANNUITY INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Great-West Life and Annuity Insurance Company, Great-West Life Assurance Company and Futurefunds Series Account for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the transactions described in the application. PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved the portion of a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-84-2) that allows the introduction of new series of index options with as few as 16 days left to expiration. (Rel. 34-21067)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-84-19) to amend Amex Rules 300 and 301 (Submission of Documents), 341 (Corporate Officers), and 344 (Nominal Employment).
