ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

DECISION SUSPENDING KEITH E. WENTZ AND RONALD P. BYNUM FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge suspending Keith E. Wentz, of San Francisco, and Ronald P. Bynum of Burlingame, California from association with any broker or dealer for 60 and 20 days, respectively, has become final. The suspensions are effective July 16.

The law judge found that, during 1980, Wentz, who was senior vice president of a brokerage firm, prepared and distributed a false and misleading research report respecting Gulf Energy Corporation, and that Bynum, a salesman, made fraudulent predictions to a customer concerning price rises in Gulf stock. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

STEVEN A. KUNA, JR. FOUND GUILTY

The U.S. Attorney's Office for the Northern District of Illinois and the Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 22 Steven A. Kuna, Jr., of Wyoming, Michigan, was found guilty of mail fraud and false statements. Judge Susan Getzendanner, after a non-jury trial, found Kuna guilty of five counts of mail fraud and one count of false statements to a federal agency in a scheme to defraud 34 limited partners of Steven Kuna and Associates (Associates) of \$1,350,000 [Associates was a Michigan limited partnership which traded as a market-maker at the Chicago Board Options Exchange]. The fraudulent scheme involved the conversion of about \$150,000 of Associates' funds, the mailing of false financial reports, and the filing of a false broker-dealer registration application with the Commission. Kuna was found not guilty of five other mail fraud counts. Before trial, the four securities counts were dismissed by the Court. Sentencing is set for July 24. (U.S. v. Steven A. Kuna, Jr., ND IL, 83 CR 921). (LR-10445)

PERMANENT APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission permanently approved a rule change filed by the Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-84-8). The rule change allows OCC to reimburse itself from its Stock Clearing Fund and Non-Equity Securities Clearing Fund for losses due to the failure of banks used by OCC for clearance and settlement operations. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
