## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST PORTLAND INVESTMENT ADVISER

The Commission simultaneously instituted and settled public administrative proceedings against Capital Matter\$, Ltd., a Portland, Oregon investment adviser registered with the Commission, and Todd Clark Holm, its president, finding violations of Exchange Act registration and Exchange Act and Advisers Act antifraud provisions in the offer and sale of promissory notes related to a purported medical factoring program. Without admitting or denying the allegations, the company consented to a 30-day suspension as an investment adviser and Holm consented to the imposition of a 30-day suspension from association with any investment adviser or broker or dealer. ### STOP ORDER ISSUED AS TO REGISTRATION STATEMENT OF SAN SABA NU-TECH, INC.

The Commission issued an order instituting proceedings under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933, making findings and suspending the effectiveness of a registration statement filed in September 1983 by San Saba Nu-Tech, Inc. (Nu-Tech). The registration statement was filed in connection with a planned public offering of up to 40 million shares of Nu-Tech common stock at \$.10 per share. Nu-Tech consented to the order without admitting or denying the findings contained therein.

In the order, the Commission found that Nu-Tech's registration statement contained untrue statements of material facts and omitted to state material facts required to be stated therein or necessary in order to make the statements therein not misleading, respecting, among other things, new products to be manufactured by Nu-Tech, the plan of distribution of the stock, the intended uses of the proceeds of the offering, and the background of management. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### SAN SABA NU-TECH, INC., OTHERS ENJOINED

The U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia permanently enjoined San Saba Nu-Tech, Inc. (Nu-Tech) and San Saba Energy, Inc. (Energy), of Twin Falls, Idaho, and their principal officers, Norvin T. Tripple and Norman J. Thouvenelle, from violating registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, and Energy, Tripple and Thouvenelle from violating antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and a Commission rule thereunder and ordered certain ancillary relief. The defendants consented to the Final Judgments against them without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The complaint alleged that Tripple and Thouvenelle caused Energy to issue to all of its shareholders letters which contained untrue and misleading representations and which constituted offers to sell securities and served to condition the market for a planned public offering. According to the complaint, Tripple and Thouvenelle later caused Nu-Tech to file a registration statement with the Commission in connection with a planned offering, which registration statement contained untrue and misleading statements and omitted to make statements required to be made therein or necessary in order to make the statements made not misleading. (SEC v. San Saba Nu-Tech, Inc., et al., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 84-2921). (LR-10531)

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### AMERICAN BALANCED FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 12 to request a hearing on an application by American Balanced Fund, Inc., AMCAP Fund, Inc., American Mutual Fund, Inc., The Bond Fund of America, Inc., EuroPacific Growth Fund, Fundamental Investors, Inc., The Growth Fund of America, Inc., The Income Fund of America, Inc., The Investment Company of America, The New Economy Fund, New Perspective Fund, Inc., The Tax-Exempt Bond Fund of America, Inc., Washington Mutual Investors Fund, Inc., any other member fund to be formed in the American Funds Group of Funds, and American Funds Distributors, Inc., for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22d-1 and approving the terms of certain offers of exchange. ### GUILD FINANCE CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by Guild Finance Corporation, a limited purpose finance corporation, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14163 - Sept. 17)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### COLUMBUS AND SOUTHERN OHIO ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to issue and sell first mortgage bonds, in an amount of up to \$60 million, at competitive bidding or, in the alternative, to enter term loan agreements. (Rel. 35-23423 - Sept. 18)

### GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over the fees and expenses to be incurred in the previously authorized issuance and sale of preferred by Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the fees and expenses related to additional sales of preferred stock and first mortgage bonds. (Rel. 35-23424 - Sept. 18)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-84-22) which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to extend the temporary exemption available to certain special purpose broker-dealers from June 6, 1984 to September 28, 1984. (Rel. 34-21330)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-84-12) to amend Rule G-15 to authorize the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. to limit the business or take other remedial actions against municipal securities brokers and dealers. (Rel. 34-21331)

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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### AMERICAN AIRLINES, INC.

An order has been issued on an application by American Airlines, Inc., under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939, declaring that the trusteeship of Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, which was qualified under the Act, and the trusteeship of Manufacturers under a new indenture, dated August 31, 1984, are not

so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or the protection of investors to disqualify Manufacturers from acting as trustee under the new indenture. (Rel. TI-926)

#### CONTINENTAL HOME FINANCE CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 15 to request a hearing on an application by Continental Home Finance Corporation, a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939, declaring that the trusteeship of First National Bank of Minneapolis under two indentures of Continental is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Bank from acting as successor trustee. (Rel. TI-927)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
