ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST DONALD SHELDON & CO., INC., OTHERS

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Donald Sheldon & Co., Inc. (Registrant), a New York City registered municipal securities broker-dealer, Mary A. Schad, Registrant's Secretary/Treasurer, Melvin Feldman, Registrant's sales manager, and Jonathan H. Smith, a registered representative at Registrant. The Order for Public Proceedings alleges that, from February through December 1982, Registrant, aided and abetted by Schad, Feldman and Smith, wilfully violated the currency transactions reporting provisions of the Exchange Act by failing to file Currency Transaction Reports with the IRS, and Section 15B(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and MSRB Rules G-8(a)(xi) and G-26 by maintaining incomplete and inaccurate new account cards. The Order also alleges that, from July through September 1982, Smith violated the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act by defrauding Registrant and a certain customer by unauthorized transactions in that customer's account and the creation of fictitious accounts. In addition, the Order alleges that Feldman failed to reasonably supervise Smith, with a view to preventing Smith's violations.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Registrant, Schad, Smith and Feldman are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action under the Exchange Act is appropriate. (Rel. 34-21367)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CHEVRON CAPITAL U.S.A. INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 9 to request a hearing on an application by Chevron Capital U.S.A. Inc. for an order for exemptions from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14198 - Oct. 16)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to 27,270,790 shares of its common stock under its Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan and up to 3,613,444 shares of its common stock under the System's Employee Savings Plan from time to time through April 30, 1986. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company. The proposal (SR-PSDTC-84-11) creates a new membership class, Municipal Comparison Only Participants, for municipal securities brokers and dealers who exclusively want to use PSDTC's facilities for automated confirmation and affirmation of institutional trades in eligible municipal securities. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following filed proposed rule changes that became effective under Section 19(b)(3) (A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934: The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-84-16) clarifying the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.'s (NASD) authority to restrict the business of municipal securities brokers and dealers that are NASD members in situations where they are experiencing financial or operational difficulties. (Rel. 34-21395); The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-84-15) clarifying OCC's fees for providing risk disclosure documents. (Rel. 34-21396); The Boston Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-BSE-84-6) establishing an Exchange operations fee of \$500 imposed on each member conducting business on the trading floor of the Exchange, a post fee of \$500 for each additional post space utilized by a member, and a credit of \$50 per month per solely listed stock for each stock in which a specialist is registered. (Rel. 34-21397); and The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Phlx-84-22) extending the time period prior to which a late charge may be assessed by Phlx for a member's delinquency in paying various fees, from 30 days after notice has been mailed to 40 days after such notice. (Rel. 34-21398)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 15.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-84-28) to change the rules applicable to the use of Market Index Option Escrow Receipts by reducing the number of equity securities required to cover each short option contract and permitting the use of cash equivalents. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 15. (Rel. 34-21399)
