COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

MARY JO WHITE TO LEAVE SEC TO JOIN LAW FIRM; DEPUTY DIRECTOR GOLDEN TO SERVE AS ACTING MUNICIPAL OMBUDSMAN

The Commission today announced that Mary Jo White, Attorney Fellow and Ombudsman in the Office of Municipal Securities will leave the Commission to join Long Aldrige Norman, as a partner in the firm's Washington, D.C. office beginning June 1, 1997, practicing with its Corporate and Government Finance Group.

Susan M. Golden, Deputy Director of the Office, will temporarily serve as Acting Ombudsman within the Office of Municipal Securities. Charlotte Buford, an Attorney in the Office of Municipal Securities, will continue to assist the Ombudsman. (Press Rel. 97-24)

RESUMPTION OF NORMAL EDGAR PROCESSING

As of the morning of March 25, all aspects of EDGAR processing had returned to normal. The system was fully functional throughout the day on all primary equipment. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

RULE 3a-4 UNDER THE INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT OF 1940

The Commission issued a release adopting Rule 3a-4 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. Rule 3a-4 provides a nonexclusive safe harbor from the definition of investment company for certain programs under which investment advisory services are provided to advisory clients. Under the rule, programs that are organized and operated in a manner consistent with the rule's conditions are not required to register under the Investment Company Act of 1940 or to comply with the Act's requirements. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC v. ENVIRONMENTAL CHEMICALS GROUP, INC., CURTIS YOUNTS, JR., CALVIN SHENKIR, JR., AND CALVIN MOERBE

The Commission announced that on March 13 Judge Orlando Garcia, of the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division, entered a final judgment by default against Environmental Chemicals Group, Inc. (EnChem). The Court's final judgment enjoins EnChem from future violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and (b)(2)(B) of the Securities Exchange Act 1934, and Rules 10b-5, 13a-1, 13a-13 and 12b-20 thereunder.

The Commission's complaint alleged, among other things, that between 1992 and May 1996, EnChem and its officers and directors filed periodic reports with the Commission and distributed press releases and other materials that contained materially false and misleading representations about the company's revenues, product lines and business prospects.

EnChem was the only remaining defendant in this civil injunctive action, which the Commission filed on December 11, 1996. As the Commission announced previously, EnChem's former officers and directors, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the entry of an order permanently enjoining them from further violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act, and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1 thereunder. SEC CHARGES LAW FIRM EMPLOYEE AND STOCKBROKER WITH INSIDER TRADING

On March 25, the Commission filed a complaint against John C. Larrabee (Larrabee) of Boxford, Massachusetts, and James L. D'Angelo (D'Angelo) of Wolfeboro, New Hampshire, charging them with insider trading concerning the merger of Baybanks, Inc. (Baybanks) and Bank of Boston Corporation (Bank of Boston). The Commission's complaint alleges that D'Angelo, who was a stockbroker at the Andover, Massachusetts branch office of PaineWebber Incorporated, purchased common stock of Baybanks while in possession of material nonpublic information about the impending acquisition, and realized illegal profits of \$86,750. The complaint further alleges that D'Angelo obtained the information in the form of a "tip" from Larrabee, who was the Director of Fiduciary Services at Bingham, Dana & Gould, a Boston law firm that represented Bank of Boston in the acquisition. The case was filed in the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts and charges D'Angelo and Larrabee with violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934

(Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, D'Angelo consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, and pending final approval by the Court, to be permanently enjoined from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. D'Angelo agreed to pay disgorgement of \$86,750, plus prejudgment interest in the amount of \$8,552, and a civil penalty of \$86,750, for a total of \$182,052. [SEC v. John C. Larrabee and James L. TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND ASSET FREEZE GRANTED IN ACTION AGAINST DAVID NAMER AND MEYERS POLLOCK ROBBINS, INC.

On March 25, the Commission filed a lawsuit in U.S District Court in New York City against David I. Namer of Memphis, Tennessee, and two corporations associated with him. Also named in the suit were the New York City and Boca Raton, Florida, securities firm of Meyers Pollock Robbins, Inc., and its president Michael Ploshnick. Shelli Ploshnick, an owner of Meyers Pollock, was named as a relief defendant.

The Commission's action concerns three unregistered offerings of corporate notes conducted in 1996 by David Namer through the Meyers Pollock firm, in the total face amount of \$13.9 million. All three offerings were sold to the public on the basis of representations that the notes were fully insured and, hence, investors incurred no risk in purchasing them. The Commission alleges that these representations were false; the agreements with various insurance companies provided by Namer to investors and individuals associated with the offerings were either misrepresented or, in some cases, outright forgeries. All of the securities sold in these three offerings are presently in default.

On the day this matter was filed, the Honorable Michael B. Mukasey, Judge of the District Court of the Southern District of New York, on ex parte application of the Commission, entered a temporary restraining order prohibiting violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws by all defendants except relief defendant Shelli Ploshnick, and freezing the assets of defendants Namer and two associated corporations. The court's order also requires that defendants Michael and Shelli Ploshnick furnish security for payment by them of \$1,975,000, representing funds they received from Namer in connection with these offerings. The Commission acknowledges the assistance of the National Association of Securities Dealers in conducting its investigation. [SEC v. David I. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DREYFUS/LAUREL FUNDS TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Dreyfus/Laurel Funds Trust, et al. for an order pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit a series of the Company to acquire all of the assets and assume all of the stated liabilities of a series of the Trust. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-22580 - March 24)

THE ADVISORS' INNER CIRCLE FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Advisors' Inner Circle Fund for an order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit in-kind redemptions of shares of certain open-end registered investment companies by shareholders who are "affiliated persons" of the investment companies solely by reason of owning, controlling, or holding the power to vote, five percent or more of the investment companies' outstanding shares. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GPU, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing GPU, Inc. (GPU), a registered holding company, to deliver letters of credit (L/Cs) through December 31, 2006, not to exceed in the aggregate \$40 million, in support of certain insurance reimbursement obligations of various GPU subsidiaries, and related transactions. Jurisdiction has been reserved over GPU's entry into reimbursement agreements in respect of L/Cs for two utility subsidiaries, pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-26690)

NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary companies, Charter Oak Energy, Inc. (Charter Oak) and COE Development Corporation, to authorize certain intermediate subsidiary companies to pay dividends to their parent companies, and for Charter Oak to use such funds to pay dividends to NU, in each case from time to time, out of capital or unearned surplus, and to the extent permitted by applicable corporate law.
