ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

JERRY ALLISON CONSENTS TO ENTRY OF COMMISSION ORDER BARRING HIM FROM SECURITIES INDUSTRY

On March 26, the Division of Enforcement instituted an administrative proceeding pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Jerry G. Allison (Allison), the former president and 90 percent owner of Qualified Pensions, Inc. (QPI). Simultaneously, Allison consented to the entry of an administrative order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company, based on the entry of an injunction in SEC v. Qualified Pensions, Inc., et al., Civ. Act. No. 95-1746 (LFO)(D.D.C.). In that action, which was filed on September 13, 1995, the Commission alleged, among other things, that Allison and QPI defrauded investors by misappropriating millions of dollars in retirement savings that were entrusted to QPI by its clients to be maintained in Individual Retirement Accounts and other retirement savings plans. On June 17, 1997, the Court entered a permanent injunction against Allison enjoining him from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b), 15(a), and 15(c) of the Exchange Act, and Exchange Act Rule 10b-5. DAVID COLVIN, INTELLINET PUBLISHING, INC., INTELLINET HOLDING GROUP, INC., MEDICAL ADVANTAGE, INC., LAMELLI, INC., a/k/a LAMELLI MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY, INC., WALL STREET RESEARCH COMPANY, INC., JOB KJELL HOVIK, and JOHN LARSON, a/k/a JOHN ST. JOHN PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED FROM FUTURE ANTIFRAUD AND REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS; LAMAR ELLIS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on March 16 the Honorable Alicemarie H. Stotler, U.S. District Judge for the Central District of California, issued an order of preliminary injunction against defendants David Colvin, J. Kjell Hovik, Intellinet Publishing, Inc., Intellinet Holding Group, Inc., Medical Advantage, Inc., Lamelli, Inc. and Wall Street Research Company, Inc.; and entered a permanent injunction against Defendant Lamar Ellis, pursuant to his consent, permanently enjoining him from violations of the antifraud provisions of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Court also appointed a permanent receiver over the entity Defendants and continued a previous order freezing the Defendants' assets and prohibiting the destruction of documents. On March 2, 1998, the Court issued a preliminary injunction against Defendant John Larson.

The Commission's complaint, filed February 19, 1998, alleges that the Defendants raised more than \$5 million since January 1997 misrepresenting, among other things, that former U.S. Surgeon General C. Everett Koop and television journalist Tom Brokaw were affiliated with Defendant Medical Advantage, and that defendants Medical Advantage, Intellinet and Lamelli were the subjects of imminent public stock offerings. JUDGMENT ENTERED IN SEC v. WESTERN EXECUTIVE GROUP, INC., ET AL.

On March 10, the Honorable George H. King, United States District Court Judge for the Central District of California, entered a Judgment permanently enjoining Charles R. Rietz (Rietz), Robert R. Parrish (Parrish), Robert J. Struth (Struth) and R. Stephen Edgel (Edgel) from selling unregistered securities and selling securities by fraudulent means. Also, Parrish, Struth and Edgel were permanently enjoined from operating as unregistered broker-dealers.

In addition, the Judgment includes an order that Rietz pay disgorgement of \$212,077; that Parrish pay disgorgement of \$188,311; that Struth pay disgorgement of \$149,885; and that Edgel pay disgorgement of \$44,823. Each of these defendants was ordered to pay a civil penalty in the same amount.

The Commission alleged in its complaint filed in October of 1996 that the defendants violated Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), the registration provisions, and Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section

10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, the antifraud provisions. The complaint also charged Parrish, Struth and Edgel with violations of Section 15(a) of the Exchange Act, the broker-dealer registration provision. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMP LIMITED, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by AMP Limited, Henderson PLC, and Seligman Henderson Co. (Sub-adviser) under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting relief from Section 15(a) of the Act. The order permits the implementation without prior shareholder approval of new sub-advisory agreements (New Agreements) between the Sub-adviser and J. & W. Seligman & Co. Incorporated relating to various registered investment companies in connection with the acquisition of Henderson PLC by AMP Limited. The order covers a period of up to 150 days following the later of: (i) the date on which the assignment of the existing investment sub-advisory agreements is deemed to have occurred, or (ii) March 25, 1998 (but in no event later than October 1, 1998) (Interim Period). The order also permits the Sub-adviser to receive all fees earned under the New Agreements during the Interim Period following shareholder approval. (Rel. IC-23078 - March 25)

DONALDSON, LUFKIN & JENRETTE SECURITIES CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 16, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by Donaldson, Lufkin & Jenrette Securities Corporation (DLJ) for an order under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting Trust Enhanced Dividend Securities trusts for which DLJ will serve as a principal underwriter (collectively, Trusts) from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act, under Section 6(c) of the Act exempting the Trusts from Section 14(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(b) of the Act exempting DLJ and the Trusts from Section 17(a) of the Act. The requested order would (i) permit other registered investment companies, and companies excepted from the definition of investment company under Sections 3(c)(1) and (c)(7) of the Act, to own a greater percentage of the total outstanding voting stock (Securities) of each Trust than that permitted by Section 12(d)(1), (ii) exempt the Trusts from the initial net worth requirements of Section 14(a), and (iii) permit the Trusts to purchase U.S. government securities from DLJ at the time of a Trust's initial issuance of Securities. NEW YORK LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITY CORPORATION VARIABLE UNIVERSAL LIFE SEPARATE ACCOUNT-II

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that New York Life Insurance and Annuity Corporation Variable Universal Life Separate Account-II has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-23087 - March 26)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to issue, no later than December 31, 2002, up to one million shares of its common stock to be used to acquire the stock or assets of one or more "energy-related companies," as defined in Rule 58 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act, as amended. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-98-06) that will amend the CHX's rules to clarify which association persons are required to register with, or be acceptable to, the CHX. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 30. (Rel. 34-39804)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange relating to the distribution of amendments to the Options Disclosure Document (SR-AMEX-98-13) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 30. (Rel. 34-39805)
