ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ADVEST, INC. AND DAVID BARR

The Commission announced that it issued an Order Instituting Public Administrative and Cease and Desist Proceedings Pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 15(b)(4), 15(b)(6) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Advest, Inc., a broker-dealer with its headquarters in Hartford, Connecticut, and David T. Barr, an Advest branch manager residing in Ithaca, New York. The Order alleges that between February and August 1993, Advest and Barr sold 350,000 shares of unregistered stock in International Trade & Commerce Corp., a worthless shell corporation, to approximately 40 investors. The Order alleges that Advest and Barr failed to investigate whether the ITC stock required registration. The Order also alleges that Barr distributed false information releases, which stated that ITC was acquiring other businesses and planned to conduct a public offering of its stock. The Order alleges that Barr knew or was reckless in not knowing that the statements in the information releases were false. The Order alleges that Advest and Barr willfully violated Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933, and that Barr willfully violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act. A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the foregoing allegations are true, and, if so, what remedial sanctions are appropriate and in the public interest and whether a cease and desist order should issue. BOSTON INVESTMENT ADVISOR AND ITS PRINCIPAL SANCTIONED FOR FALSE ADVERTISING CLAIMS

The Commission issued an order against Reservoir Capital Management, Inc. (Reservoir) and RoAnn Costin (Costin) finding that from approximately March 1994 to May 1996, Reservoir and Costin distributed to prospective clients advertising and other promotional materials that overstated Reservoir's performance by approximately 100% and inflated the assets under Reservoir's management by up to 2500%. The order also finds that, at times, certain of Reservoir's marketing materials contained a list of "representative clients" which was false and misleading in that Reservoir had no investment advisory relationship with certain of the "clients" on the list.

The order also found that, through Costin, Reservoir made certain false and misleading filings with the Commission; failed to maintain certain required books and records; and did not provide certain required written disclosure statements to clients.

Reservoir and Costin simultaneously settled this matter consenting to the following relief: (i) cease and desist orders; (ii) censures; and (iii) civil monetary penalties in the amounts of \$50,000 for Reservoir and \$25,000 for Costin. In addition, the Commission has ordered Reservoir to comply with certain remedial undertakings, including retaining the services of an independent consultant to review certain of its procedures. Reservoir and Costin neither admitted or denied the findings. (Rel. IA-1717; File No. 3-9584)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ALBERT YESNER

On April 27, the Commission issued an Order instituting administrative proceedings against Albert Glenn Yesner. The Order alleges that Yesner, who is a certified public accountant and was Sensormatic Electronics Corporation's Controller and then Director of Business Controls, violated, and aided and abetted and caused Sensormatic's violations of, various provisions of the federal securities laws, including the antifraud, reporting, internal controls, books and records, and representation-to-auditors provisions, and that he engaged in improper professional conduct.

The Order alleges, among other things, that Yesner participated in Sensormatic's improper recognition of revenue because, although he was aware that shipping documents were backdated to prematurely record revenue and knew that recognizing revenue on post-period shipments was not in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles or the company's stated revenue recognition policy, he failed to inform the Audit Committee of Sensormatic's Board of Directors or the independent auditors about these and other practices. The Order also alleges that, during the audit for fiscal year 1994, Yesner learned that a Sensormatic employee had been instructed to withhold from the auditors documents that would have disclosed improper recognition of revenue, and that he told the employee that his choices were essentially to follow orders or quit.

A hearing will be held to determine whether the staff allegations are true, to afford Yesner an opportunity to establish any defenses, and to determine whether the Commission should issue a cease and desist order and what, if any, remedial action against Yesner is appropriate pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. COMMISSION SUES FIVE IN REGULATION S MICROCAP FRAUD SCHEME

On April 23, the Commission filed a microcap market manipulation case involving Alter Sales Co., Inc. (ASI), a Florida automotive parts distributor. Named as defendants are Marc A. Osheroff, former president and CEO of ASI; Barry Gesser, formerly ASI's public

relations agent; Robert S. Mitchell, a former ASI employee and business partner of Osheroff; Glen T. Vittor, formerly President of Sovereign Equity Management Corp., a registered broker-dealer; and Sheldon Maschler, formerly a broker at Datek Securities Corp. The complaint seeks, among other things, permanent injunctions against all the defendants from violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 and against Osheroff, Gesser, Mitchell and Vittor from violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. It also seeks disgorgement of illegal profits, prejudgment interest, and civil penalties. The Commission alleges that Osheroff and others caused ASI to issue four million shares of unregistered stock in fraudulent Reg S offerings, at discounts of up to 85 percent. The shares were resold on a U.S. market hyped by false press releases, for illegal profits totalling \$6.5 million. [SEC v. Marc A. Osheroff, Barry Gesser, Robert S. Mitchell, Glen T. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE AMERICAS GROWTH FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 19, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by The Americas Growth Fund, Inc. and JW Charles Financial Services, Inc. for an order under Section 57(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would permit a business development company to complete a merger with an affiliated person. (Rel. IC-23126 - April 23)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange. The proposal, (SR-CHX-98-7), amends Rules 14, 15, 16, 17 and 22 of Article XXVIII, and the interpretation and policy .01 of Rule 2 of Article XXVIII. The proposal clarifies the requirements for listing and/or maintenance on the CHX a security that is also listed on another primary market. The proposal also amends maintenance and delisting standards regarding securities listed on Tier II of the CHX. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 27. (Rel. 34-39906)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-09) relating to Trade Match Delayed Submission Fees. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 27. (Rel. 34-39910)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-07) relating to the Committee responsible for governing RAES participation in SPX. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 27. (Rel. 34-39911)
