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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### COMMISSION MEETING - CHANGE IN THE MEETING

The closed meeting scheduled for Thursday, December 17, 1998, at 11:00 a.m., has been changed to Wednesday, December 16, 1998, at 2:00 p.m.

### RICHARD LINDSEY TO TESTIFY

Richard R. Lindsey, Director of the Division of Market Regulation, will testify at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 16, 1998, before the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry. The testimony, concerning over-the-counter derivatives in the U.S. financial markets, will take place in Room 328a of the Russell Senate Office Building.

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## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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### MICHAEL TRABA, PORTFOLIO MANAGER, CHARGED WITH FRAUD IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

On December 10, the Commission instituted administrative and cease-and-desist proceedings against Michael P. Traba, formerly an employee of First National Bank of Chicago (First Chicago). The order instituting proceedings alleges that in 1994, while acting as the senior portfolio manager of two money market funds advised by First Chicago, Traba carried out a scheme to hide significant price declines in several derivative securities owned by the money market funds. For several months Traba allegedly valued the derivatives at or near their original purchase prices at a time when their market values had declined significantly. When instructed to sell the derivatives, Traba allegedly arranged a shell game by selling the derivatives and other securities at inflated prices to trust accounts under his control, thus transferring losses from the mutual funds to the trust accounts. Through this conduct, Traba allegedly violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and reporting provisions of the Investment Company Act. He also allegedly caused and aided and abetted violations of pricing and recordkeeping provisions of the Investment Company Act.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and, if so, whether a cease-and-desist order and other remedial sanctions should be entered. (Rel. 33-7617; 34-40772; IC-23595; File No. 3-9788)

#### **PROCEEDINGS AGAINST JOSEPH CHIULLI REMANDED**

On December 11, the Commission granted the unopposed motion of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., to remand these proceedings so that the NASD may rule on a reconsideration motion. (Rel. 34-40781; File No. 3-9776)

#### **SAFETECH INDUSTRIES ENJOINED**

On September 18, 1998, the Commission filed a civil action in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia against Safetech Industries, Inc. (Safetech) to compel Safetech to file its delinquent periodic reports and to enjoin Safetech from future violations of Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 12b-25, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. On December 2, 1998, the District Court entered a final judgment by default enjoining Safetech from violating Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and the rules thereunder; and compelling Safetech to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1998, and its Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for the fiscal quarters ended December 31, 1997 and June 30, 1998. #### **COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST WARPNET HOLDINGS, LLC AND KEVIN TAUBER**

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Utah, on December 11 seeking a temporary restraining order, an asset freeze and other relief against WARPnet Holdings, LLC, and Kevin A. Tauber based on allegations that WARPnet, ostensibly a provider of advance Internet technology, and Tauber sold interests in WARPnet by falsely claiming the company had agreements to provide Internet services for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, the Salt Lake Organizing Committee for the Olympic Winter Games of 2002, the Western Governors University and the Rolling Stones rock band. The complaint also alleges Tauber told investors he was a personal friend of Michael O. Leavitt, Governor of Utah, and Gordon B. Hinkley, President of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Neither Governor Leavitt nor President Hinkley recalls having heard of Tauber.

The complaint alleges that since the summer of 1998, WARPnet, a Missouri limited liability company, and Tauber, originally a resident of Columbia, Missouri, but currently living in a Salt Lake City hotel, have sold units in WARPnet to investors in Utah and California by telling potential investors that they would receive a percentage of the profits to be realized by WARPnet from its services contracts with the above-mentioned and other entities and

that WARPnet would repurchase any interests after one year at a profit to the investor of \$2 per unit.

It is alleged that by engaging in such conduct WARPnet and Tauber have violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. On December 11, the Honorable Dale Kimball, United States District Judge, issued a temporary restraining order and an asset freeze against WARPnet and Tauber and set a hearing on the Commission's motion for preliminary injunction for December 18, 1998. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NORTHERN INSTITUTIONAL FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 4, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by Northern Institutional Funds, et al. for an order under Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 18f-2 under the Act, and from certain disclosure requirements under the Act. The order would permit applicants to hire subadvisers and materially amend subadvisory agreements without shareholder approval, and grant relief from certain disclosure requirements. (Rel. ### KEMPER GLOBAL/INTERNATIONAL SERIES, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Kemper Global/International Series, Inc. (Company) and Scudder Kemper Investments, Inc., granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit redemptions in kind of shares of The Growth Fund of Spain (Fund), a portfolio of the Company held by certain affiliated shareholders of the Fund. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC., CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, to amend its certificate of incorporation to increase the number of authorized shares of AEP common stock from 300 million to 600 million shares. (Rel. 35-26951)

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### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-98-39) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act to increase the current position and exercise limits for narrow-based index options. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 14. (Rel. 34-40757)

The National Association of Securities Dealers has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-98-79) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act relating to issuer responsibilities when using the internet, updating MarketWatch contact information, and other matters. The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-48) relating to the Exchange's Rapid Opening System (ROS). Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 14. (Rel. 34-40780)

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-98-13) filed by The Options Clearing Corporation under Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposed rule change clarifies OCC's adjustment and settlement procedures for currency related options in anticipation of the European Union conversion to the euro. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 14. (Rel. 34-40779)
