ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS AGAINST GEORGE SALLOUM

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against George Salloum (Salloum), a trader and the former head trader at Thomas James Associates, Inc. (TJA), a Rochester, New York broker-dealer. The Order for Proceedings alleges that Salloum violated and aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws through his participation in a fraudulent scheme whereby TJA, in connection with TJA's underwritings of the initial public offerings for Sunrise Technologies, Inc., Phoenix Laser Systems, Inc., Megamation, Inc., and International Superconductor Corp., created an artificially large demand for these stocks by TJA customers through its undisclosed domination and control of the market for these stocks and fraudulent and high pressure sales techniques. The order also alleges that Salloum, as head trader, caused TJA to charge its customers undisclosed excessive markups. The Order further alleges Salloum is presently permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Salloum consented to the entry of this Final Order of Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the allegations against him. A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford Salloum an opportunity to present any defenses thereto. (Rel. 34-28489)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

VIPIN SAHGAL PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

On October 4, the Honorable A. Andrew Hauk, U.S. District Judge, Central District of California, entered Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and an Order Permanently Enjoining defendant Vipin Sahgal, and a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against defendant Vipin Sahgal, permanently enjoining him from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Order and Final Judgment were entered after a trial on the merits which began on August 13, 1990, and was completed on August 17, 1990. Judge Hauk had previously, on August 17, 1990, entered a default Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Rana Research, Inc., permanently enjoining Rana Research from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Commission filed its Complaint in this action on March 30, 1989. [SEC v. Rana Research, Inc. (d/b/a Vista Group, Ltd.) and Vipin Sahgal, USDC for the Central District of California, Civil Action No. 89-1865] (LR-12659)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE MEXICO EQUITY AND INCOME FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 30, 1990 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Mexico Equity and Income Fund, Inc. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicant from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit applicant to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. AMERICAN REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY

A correction has been issued to a Commission order issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (IC-17708 - August 29, 1990). The order permits the applicants to substitute shares of some portfolios of the PaineWebber Series Trust (Trust) for shares of other portfolios of the Trust. The correction clarifies that shares of the Global Income Portfolio are to be substituted for shares of the High Yield Bond Portfolio and shares of the Corporate Bond Portfolio. The shares are held by certain variable annuity accounts of American Republic Insurance Company and American Benefit Life Insurance Company. (Rel. IC-17708A - October 4)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

On October 1, the Commission approved a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-90-07) which provides for the disbursement of funds upon acquisition or liquidation. Publication of the order approving the proposal is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of October 9. (Rel. 34-28500)

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-90-18) that increases the size of orders eligible to be routed automatically through the Exchange's Automated Options Market (AUTOM) system, a pilot program that allows electronic delivery of options orders from member firms directly to the appropriate specialist on the PHLX options trading floor. Publication of the approval is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of October 9. (Rel. 34-28516)
