CARREL APPLICATIONS NOW BEING ACCEPTED

Pursuant to the rules of the Public Reference Room, the January allocation of carrels and telephone privileges for recognized user organizations (information dissemination companies) are now being accepted. Application forms are available in the Public Reference Room. Information dissemination companies that are unable to pick up forms

in Washington may submit applications by writing to April Keyes, Branch Chief, Public Reference, Securities and Exchange Commission, Room 1024, Mail Stop 1-2, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Applications must include: a brief description of the business, the business address, the business telephone number, the name of a person who will serve as on-site contact in the Room, the names of all persons who work every day in the Room, the number of employees assigned to research/sales of SEC filings, regardless of work location, and the number of carrels requested. Applicants may also submit a supplemental statement in support of their request for carrel/telephone privileges. The applications must be certified and signed by a responsible company official and submitted by the close of business January 4, 1991. As in the past, assignment of carrels/telephone privileges is discretionary and applicants should not assume they will receive use of the full number of carrels for which they apply. The Commission intends to continue to reserve carrels for the general public.

Revised carrel allocations will be effective January 31, 1991.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-90-55) to list and trade index warrants based on the European Index, a capitalization-weighted index consisting of 102 European stocks (Rel. 34-28670); American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-22) to amend Sections 110 and 340 of the AMEX Company Guide in order to modify the procedure for foreign issuers seeking relief under the "custom and tradition" rule and to allow listed companies to issue nontransferable rights (Rel. 34-28671; International Series Rel. No. 202); and American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-23) to permit specialists and Registered Options Traders to initiate transactions from the floor in AMEX-traded index warrants for the purpose of hedging positions in AMEX-traded index options, and to permit specialists and Registered Equity Market Makers registered in index warrants to initiate transactions from the floor in AMEX-traded options for the purpose of hedging their warrant positions (Rel. 34-28672). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 10.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-50) to amend the PORTAL Rules to delete the requirement that a PORTAL dealer, broker or qualified investor maintain a segregated account, for PORTAL Market transactions only, at agents who provide it access to a PORTAL depository organization. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 10. (Rel. 34-28678)
