ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FRANK CANNATA CONSENTS TO AN ORDER BARRING HIM FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER DEALER FOR FIVE YEARS

On February 11, the Commission issued a settled Order Instituting A Proceeding, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions Pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Order) against Frank J. Cannata, one of six defendants in a civil action pending in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York. Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Cannata consented to the Order, which is based on the prior entry of a District Court injunction and bars him from association with any broker or dealer for five years.

Cannata previously agreed to settle the District Court action, as it pertains to him, by consenting to the entry of a final judgment (final judgment) which the judge signed on January 24, 2000. The final judgment permanently enjoins Cannata from violating Sections 9(a)(2) and 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5, thereunder. These are, respectively, the anti-manipulation and antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act. The final judgment also orders Cannata to disgorge his ill-gotten gains, plus prejudgment interest thereon, but waives such disgorgement, and does not impose a civil penalty, based on his demonstrated inability to pay. Cannata consented to the entry of the final judgment without admitting or denying any allegations in the complaint, except as to jurisdiction.

The Commission's complaint in the District Court action includes the following allegations: Between May 1992 and August 1992, Cannata and four other defendants manipulated the price of the common stock of Phoenix Laser Systems, Inc., a now-defunct company that was in the business of developing a laser workstation to perform eye surgery. During this period, Cannata was associated with registered broker-dealers headquartered in New York, New York; and, beginning in July 1992, he was simultaneously employed by Phoenix as a consultant pursuant to a written agreement which provided that he would receive thousands of dollars of monthly compensation from Phoenix. As part of the scheme to manipulate the price of Phoenix common stock, which traded on the American Stock Exchange, Cannata caused a number of purchases of Phoenix common stock to be executed for the accounts of

his clients. These purchases were executed during the day and often at or near the end of the trading day, in a manner that increased the price of the stock. The end-of-day purchases frequently caused Phoenix's daily closing price to be higher than it would have been in the absence of those purchases. Although Cannata solicited and caused a number of these purchases to be executed while he was simultaneously employed by Phoenix and a registered broker-dealer, he did not disclose to the broker-dealer or to his customers that he had entered into an employment agreement with Phoenix. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSECO VARIABLE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 6, 2000, to request a hearing on an application filed by Conseco Variable Insurance Company (Conseco Variable), Conseco Variable Annuity Account H (Separate Account H), any other separate account established in the future by Conseco Variable to support certain deferred variable annuity contracts issued by Conseco Variable (Future Accounts), and Conseco Equity Sales, Inc. Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the issuance and subsequent recapture, upon exercise of the free-look cancellation right, of purchase payment credits applied to purchase payments made under: (i) certain deferred variable annuity contracts that Conseco Variable will issue through Separate Account H (Contracts), and (ii) contracts that Conseco Variable may issue in the future through Separate Account H or any Future Accounts that are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts (Future Contracts). Applicants also request that the order being sought extend to any other National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. member broker-dealer controlling or controlled by, or under common control with, Conseco Variable, whether existing or created in the future, that serves as a distributor or principal underwriter of the Contracts or any Future Contracts offered through Separate Account H or any Future Accounts. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to proposed rule changes submitted by the Pacific Exchange and the American Stock Exchange (SR-PCX-00-01 and SR-Amex-00-02) relating to exercise price intervals and exercise prices for FLEX equity options. The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-99-51) to assess a monthly capital funding fee on a permanent basis. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 14. (Rel. 34-42405)

A proposed rule change and Amendment No. 1 have been filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-00-02) to amend the schedule of listing fees for non-U.S. companies. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 14. (Rel. 34-42406)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-99-29) submitted by the American Stock Exchange relating to disclosures by specialists under Amex Rule 174. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 14. (Rel. 34-42407)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-99-17) and issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 to the proposed rule change submitted by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to amend its By-Laws relating to Trustees of Stock Exchange Fund. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected during the week of February 14. (Rel. 34-42408)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-99-10) and issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 1 to the proposed rule change submitted by the New York Stock Exchange to amend Rule 123A.40. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 14. (Rel. 34-42411)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-00-01) to amend its Minor Rule Violation System (Rule 590) by establishing a two-tier fine system and by incorporating the Floor Decorum Policy, as revised, into the Rule. The proposed rule change has become effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
